Starting on 16th Street, it cuts a swathe southwest to 5th Street East, partly a former railbed. The trail is paved and invites local residents to walk, ride or roll.

There is no dedicated parking for this trail. If coming from the surrounding neighborhoods you can access the trail on foot or by bike.



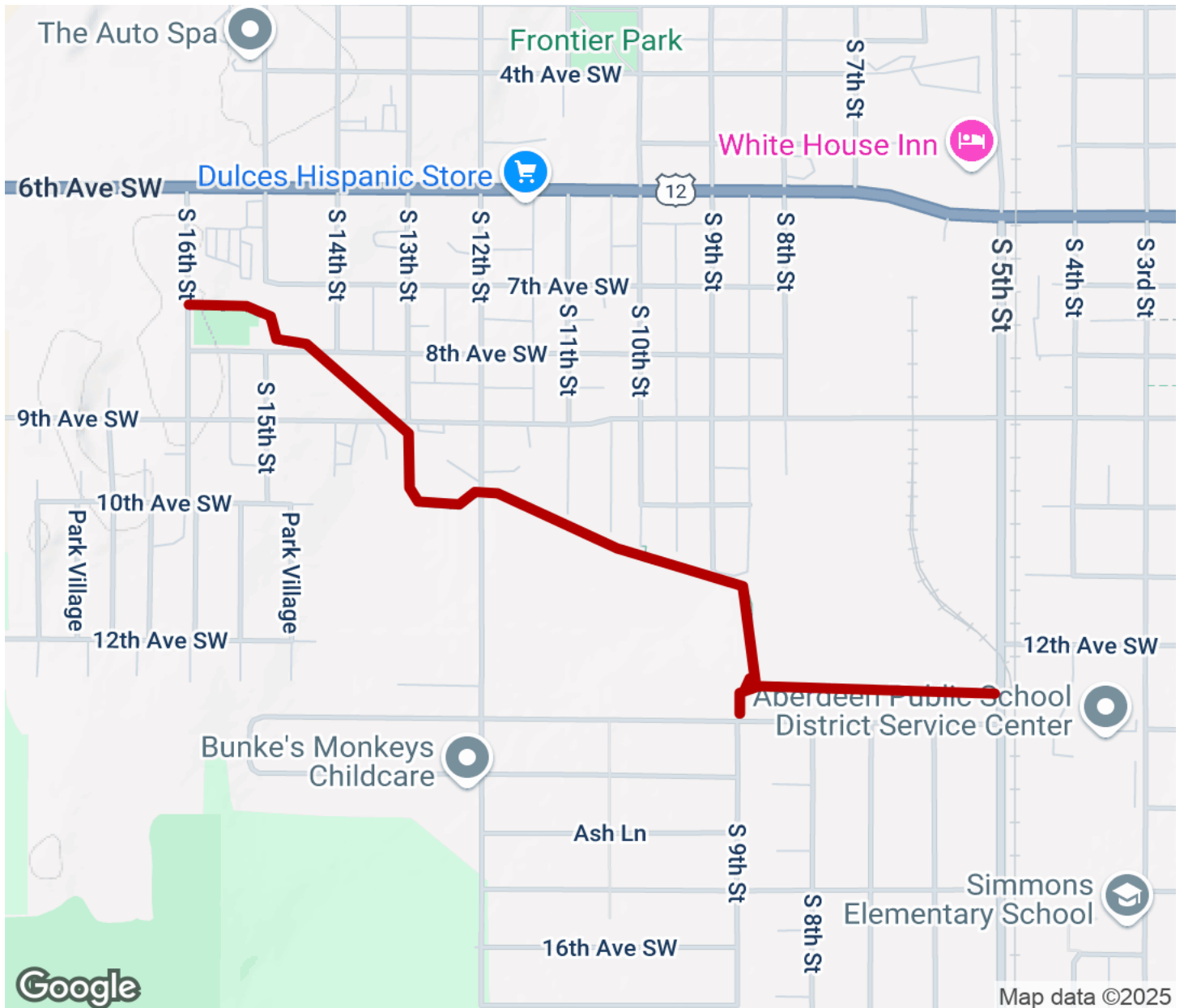
