The Alameda Bike Path is a separated bike-ped facility along Alameda Parkway/ Avenue. The paved trail stretches for over seven miles from Jewell Avenue to just east of SR 95 in Lakewood, a suburb of Denver. There are plenty of homes, schools, businesses and local parks along its length, making this pathway good for both getting in a workout and running errands. The trail intercepts the <u>Kipling Trail</u> at Kipling Parkway and the Weir Gulch Trail at its east endpoint.

Parking & Trail Access


You can park at Hayden Park at the entrance on Alameda Parkway. In your mapping application, it may be called the Green Mountain Hayden Park Entrance.
