You can also park at Barnum Recreation Center 360 Hooker St. Denver.



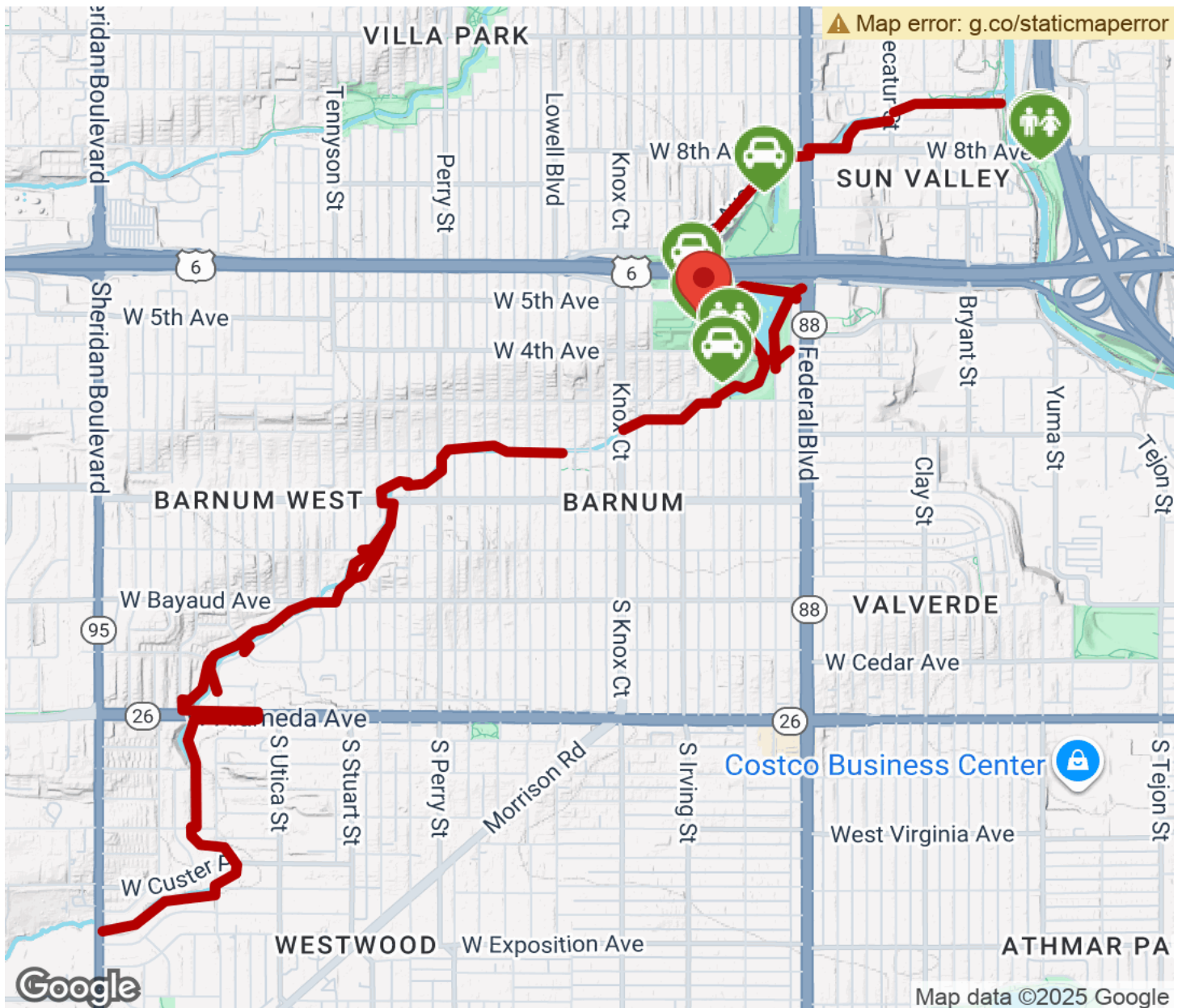
