Front Street Pathway

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Though short, this stretch of trail provides a crucial linkage between existing trails in Bozeman, MT. Located in northeast side of the city, the paved trail provides a safe bike-ped connection between the [Oak Street Pathway](#) at Rouse Avenue, over a bridge to the [Story Mill Spur Trail](#). From there, trail users can continue to the [Bozeman to Bridger Mountains Trail](#).
