Clearwater Memorial Causeway Trail

This trail connects the Pinellas Trail in Clearwater to Clearwater Beach across the Memorial Causeway. It is a wide trail, separated



of beach resorts.

This trail connects the [Pinellas Trail](#) in Clearwater to Clearwater Beach across the Memorial Causeway. It is a wide trail, separated from traffic as it slopes up Memorial Causeway Bridge. The trail stays close to the water for most of its length before it enters Clearwater Beach. There are overlooks jutting out allowing trail users to pause and enjoy in the views of Clearwater Bay. Helpfully, there's sheltered seating with trash receptacles provided at intervals.

Once the trail enters Clearwater Park it becomes significantly more crowded and you must be keen about following the trail as there may not be clear wayfinding signage at this point. The trail rounds the busy Pier 60 Park, which hosts a fishing pier and large playground, and then heads south along Gulfview Boulevard, past a series

At the east endpoint of the trail, on the southwest corner of Turner Street & East Avenue.

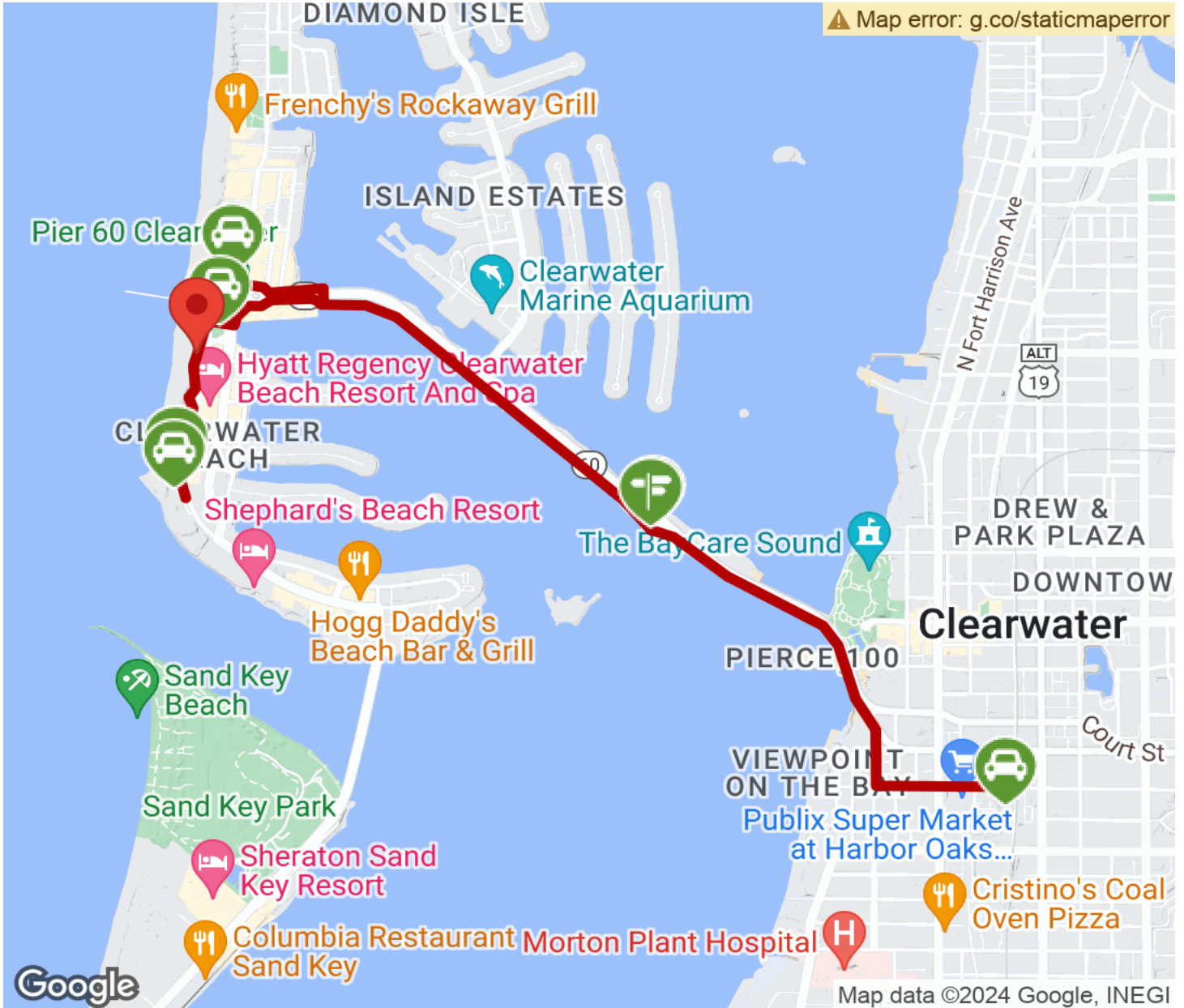

There's beach parking with bike racks and public restrooms at 430 Gulfview Boulevard at Clearwater Beach.
