The Wellington Greenway is a section of the Malden River Greenway in Medford, Massachusetts. Eventually, the Wellington

The Wellington Greenway is a section of the <u>Malden</u> <u>River Greenway</u> in Medford, Massachusetts. Eventually, the Wellington Greenway will be connected to the other sections of the Malden River Greenway in Malden and Everett.

The Wellington Greenway begins in the Park at Rivers Edge, part of a new mixed-use development. It runs along the Malden River before ending near Revere Beach Pkwy. The section from Revere Beach Pkwy to the Wellington MBTA Station should be complete in Summer 2019. Starting from the Wellington MBTA Station, the trail follows the Mystic River. Most of this section runs through Torbert MacDonald State Park, part of the Mystic River State Reservation. From the west end of the trail, you can continue along the Mystic River, or cross the
