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The Quinnipiac Linear Trail is an easy multipurpose path in Wallingford, Connecticut. The trail skirts Community Lake while traveling a heavily wooded corridor along the Quinnipiac River. It is one of a number of riverside greenways along the Quinnipiac - others include the [Quinnipiac River Gorge Trail](#) in Meriden and Quinnipiac River State Park Trail in North Haven.

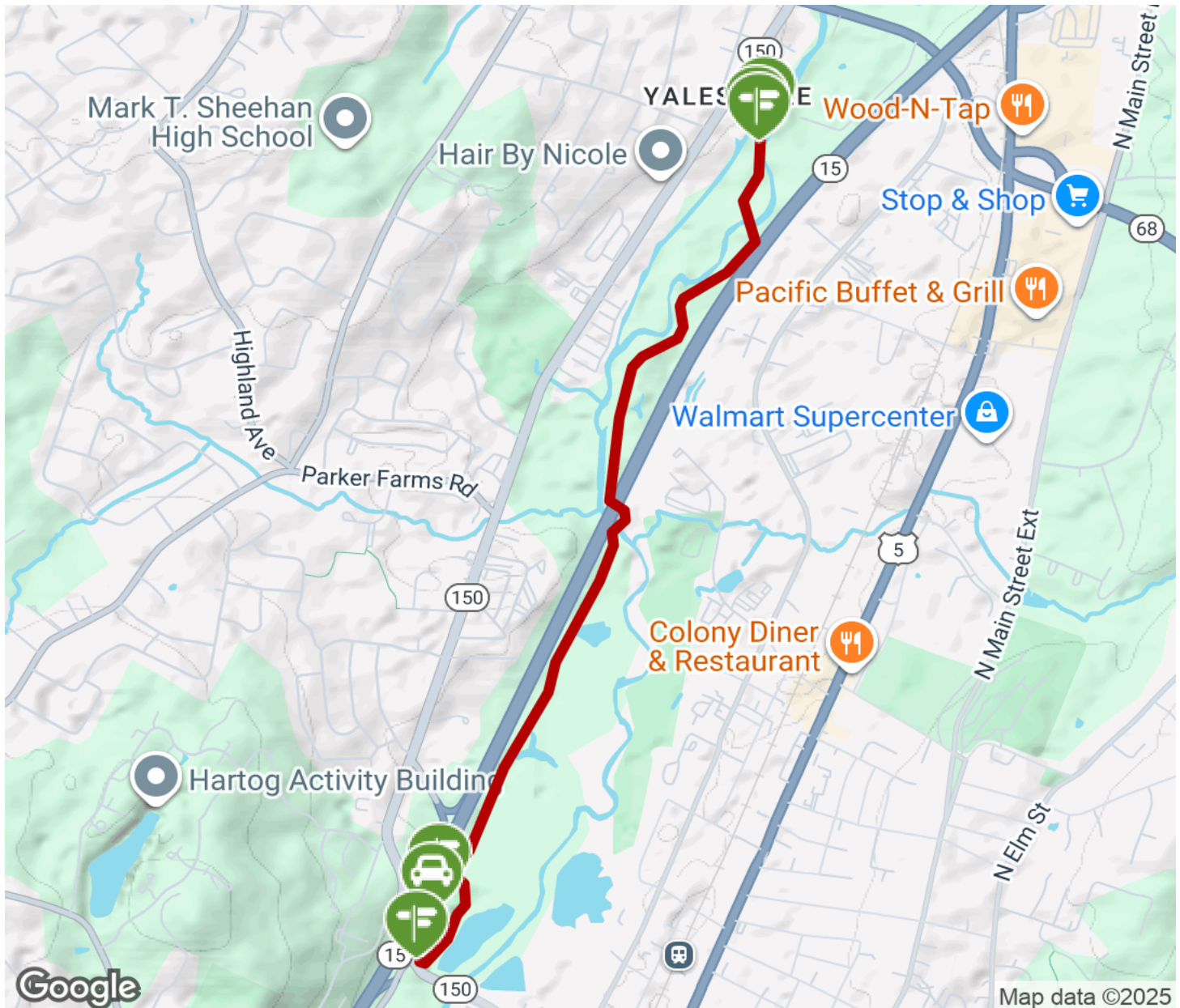
