Kill Creek Streamway Trail

The Kill Creek Streamway Trail exists in 2 segments: the northern segment begins near Lexington Avenue in De Soto and winds south



The Kill Creek Streamway Trail exists in 2 segments: the northern segment begins near Lexington Avenue in De Soto and winds south of 95th along Kill Creek. The southern segment picks up in Kill Creek Park and tracks a serpentine course south to W. 135th Street in Olathe. The two segments add up to seven miles of paved, multi-use trail, but Kill Creek Park hosts singletrack hiking and mountain-biking trails as well as equestrian paths. The park also features a swimming beach, picnic facilities, restrooms and a playground.

There are plans to connect the two trail segments, as well as to extend the trail from the Kansas River to Gardner, Kansas.

To access the southern segment, park near Shelter 1, in Kill Creek Park (11670 Homestead Lane, Olathe).



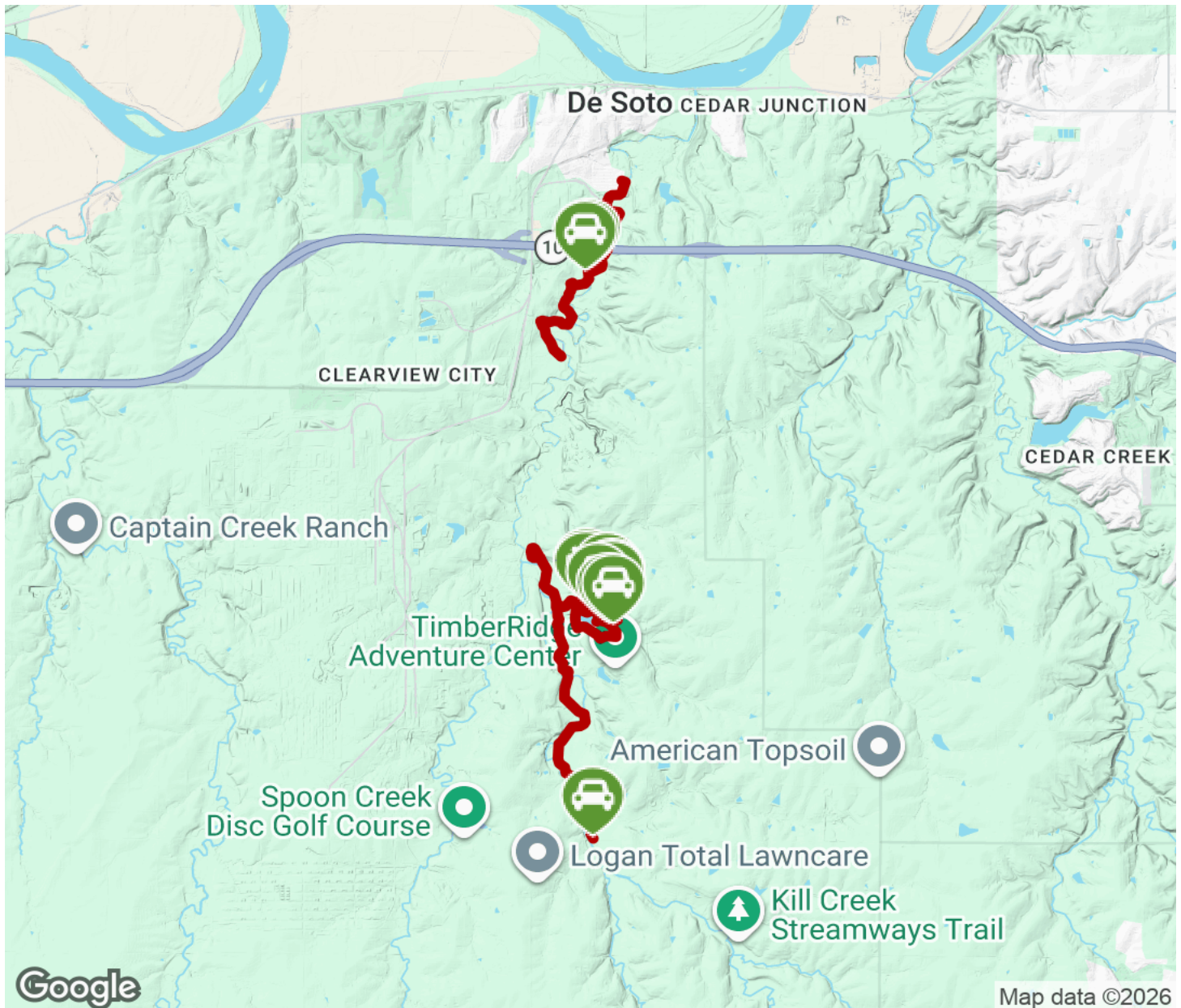
