If you're making your way along the scenic Leon Creek Greenway in western San Antonio, you might come across this lovely little



first step in the city's plans to expand their impressive trail network west along the creek.

If you're making your way along the scenic [Leon Creek Greenway](#) in western San Antonio, you might come across this lovely little spur trail off the main route. The Cathedral Rock Connector Trail takes you from the main greenway trail into Cathedral Rock Park, a well-groomed neighborhood park with a large playground and play area that makes it a great place for family recreation. The park also features a series of looping concrete paths in the wooded area behind the playground, which provide access to the adjacent Culebra Creek. Trail users are rewarded with views of the limestone rock formations along the creek bed, and you'll often be able to catch a glimpse of deer or other wildlife in this pocket of wilderness. The connector trail gives residents in the nearby neighborhoods a convenient means of accessing the park and the greenway, and serves as an important

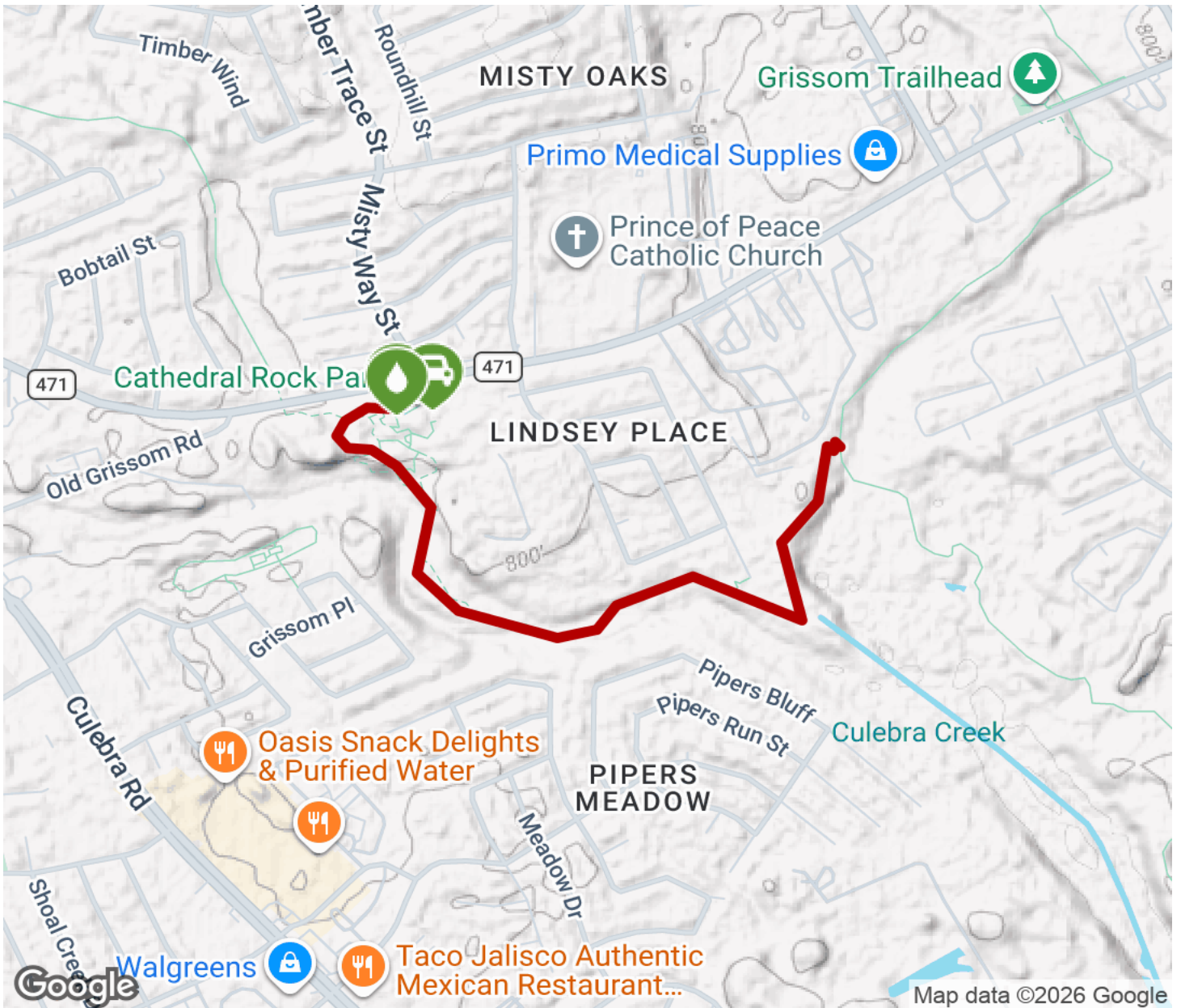
Parking & Trail Access
