This section of concrete trail traces nearly half a mile of Alazan Creek, starting on Alexander Avenue, just south of Woodlawn Lake



This section of concrete trail traces nearly half a mile of Alazan Creek, starting on Alexander Avenue, just south of Woodlawn Lake Park to its abrupt end on Lombrano Street. The trail sits on the grassy bank of the channelized creek. The hike-and-bike path is one of several measures taken to restore San Antonio's various Westside creeks, and invite neighbors back to the water.

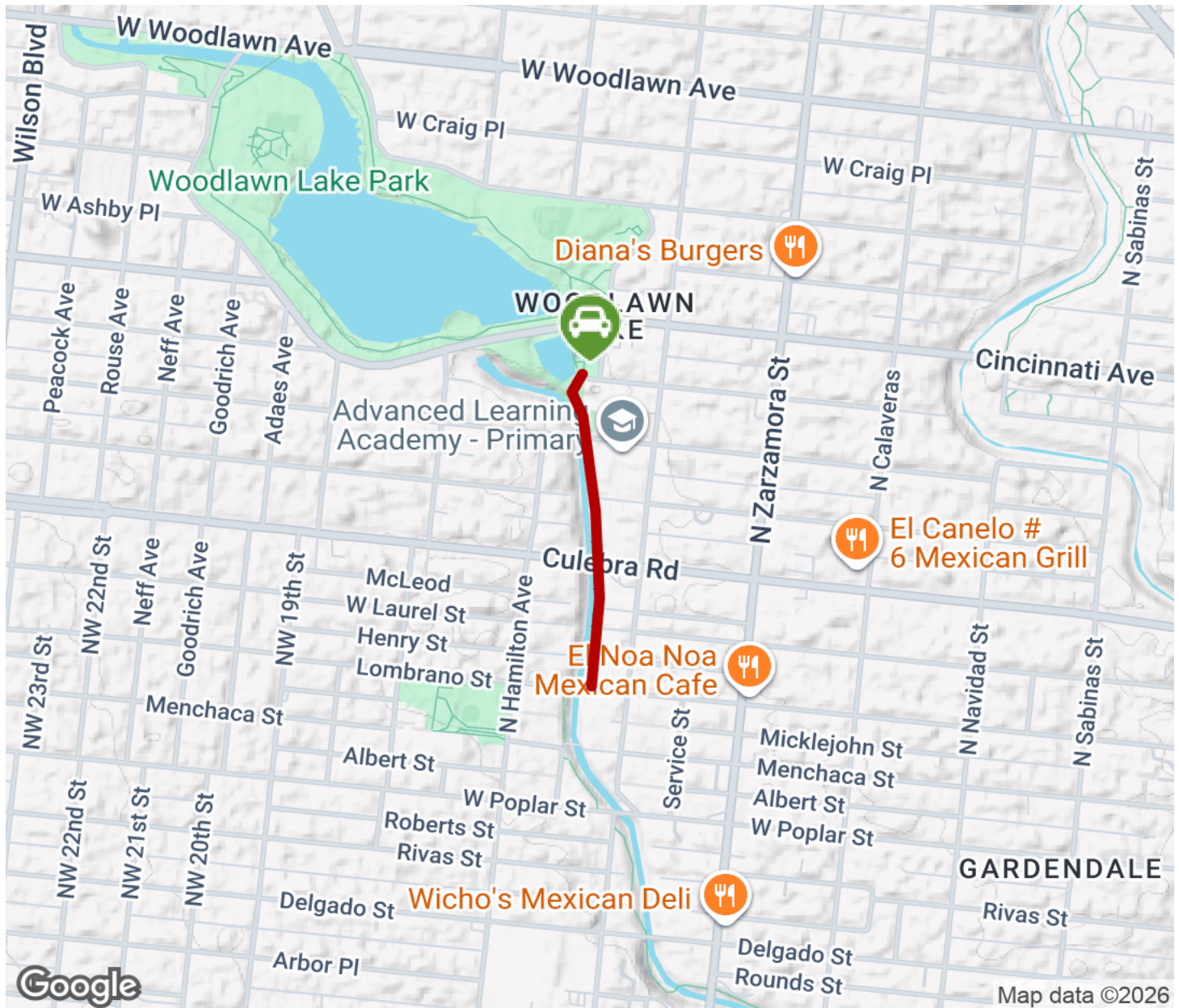
Parking & Trail Access
