The trail is nestled between landscaped green space on one side and the creek's riparian buffer on the other. It's nearly a mile long, extending from Piney Creek Drive down to Blondo Parkway. This is an easy trail, accessible to young and old alike.

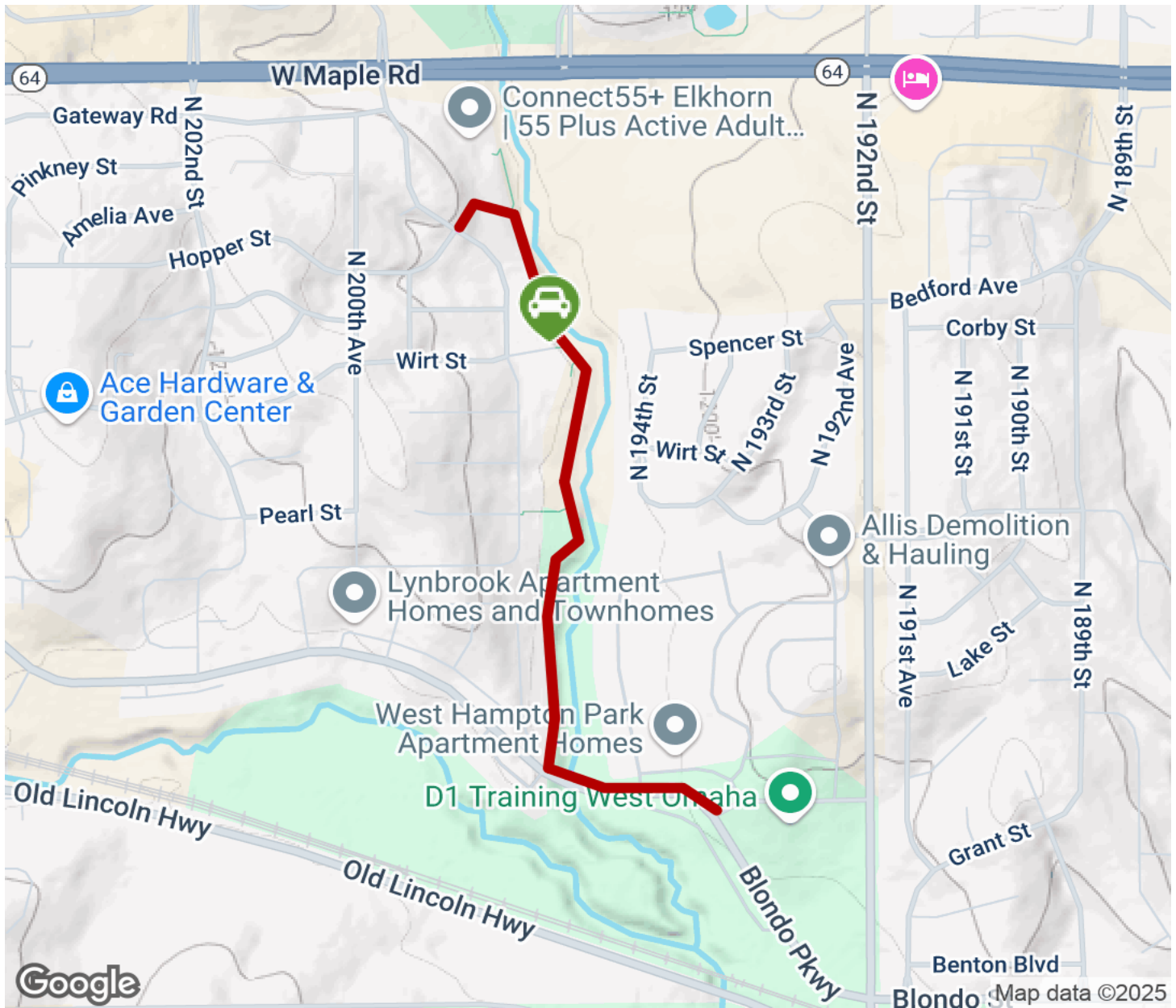
