The setting for the Madison Bike & Recreation Trail transitions from urban industrial to rural farmland as it heads east towards Johnson Point on the shores of Lake Madison. The paved path begins on Egan Avenue in the south of the city, but soon begins to parallel State Route 34, which it will stick close to for most of its route. As you head east, buildings become sparser and are replaced by panoramic fields of corn, soybeans and grain crops.

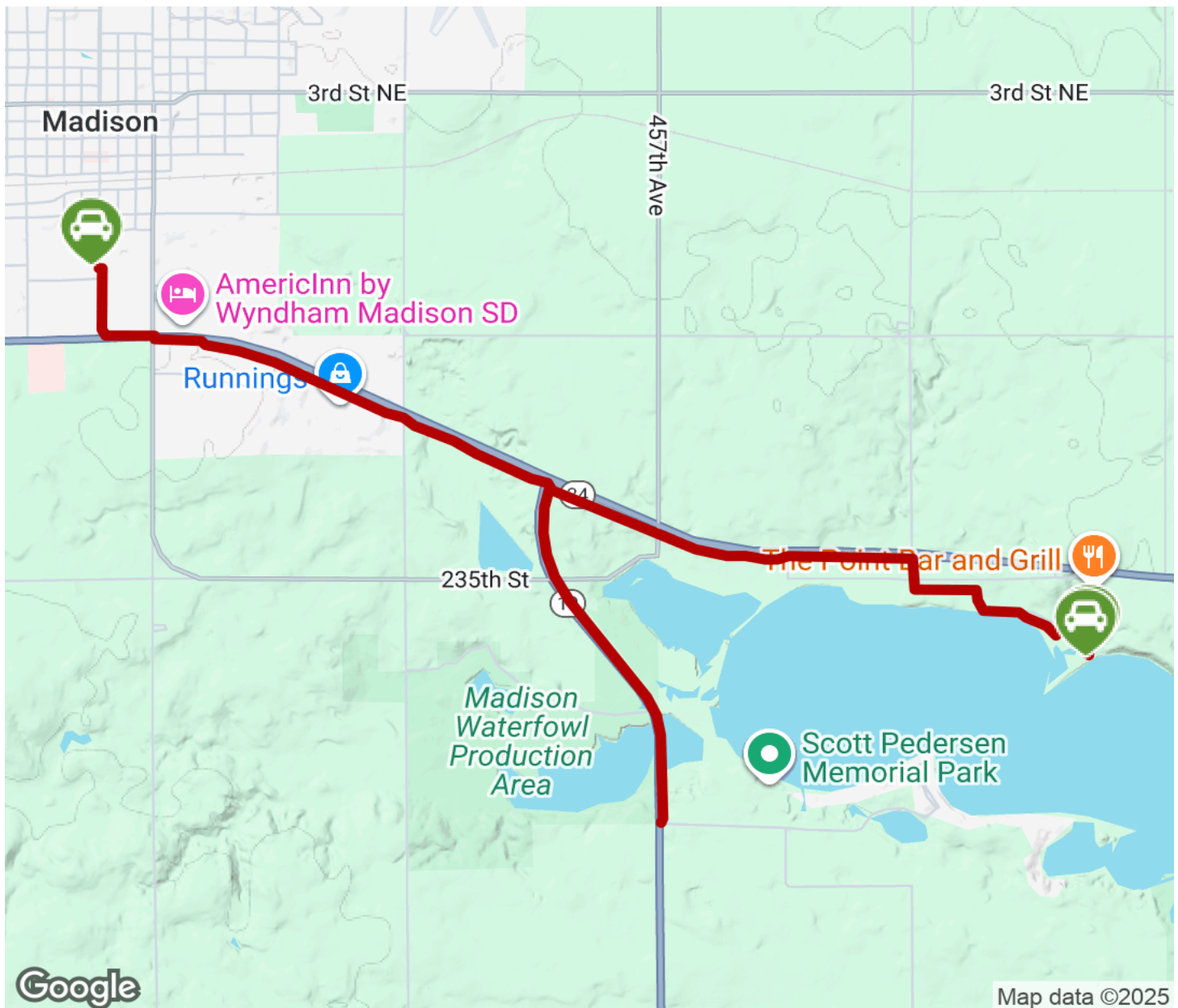
Parking & Trail Access
