The trail starts on Hill Street SE, just north of the Boys and Girls Club of Albany and heads east across Oak Street into Kinder Park. The trail winds south through the park across Geary Street and through a residential area. Follow the trail along the creek to Periwinkle Park and then further south to Grand Prairie Park, where the trail concludes.

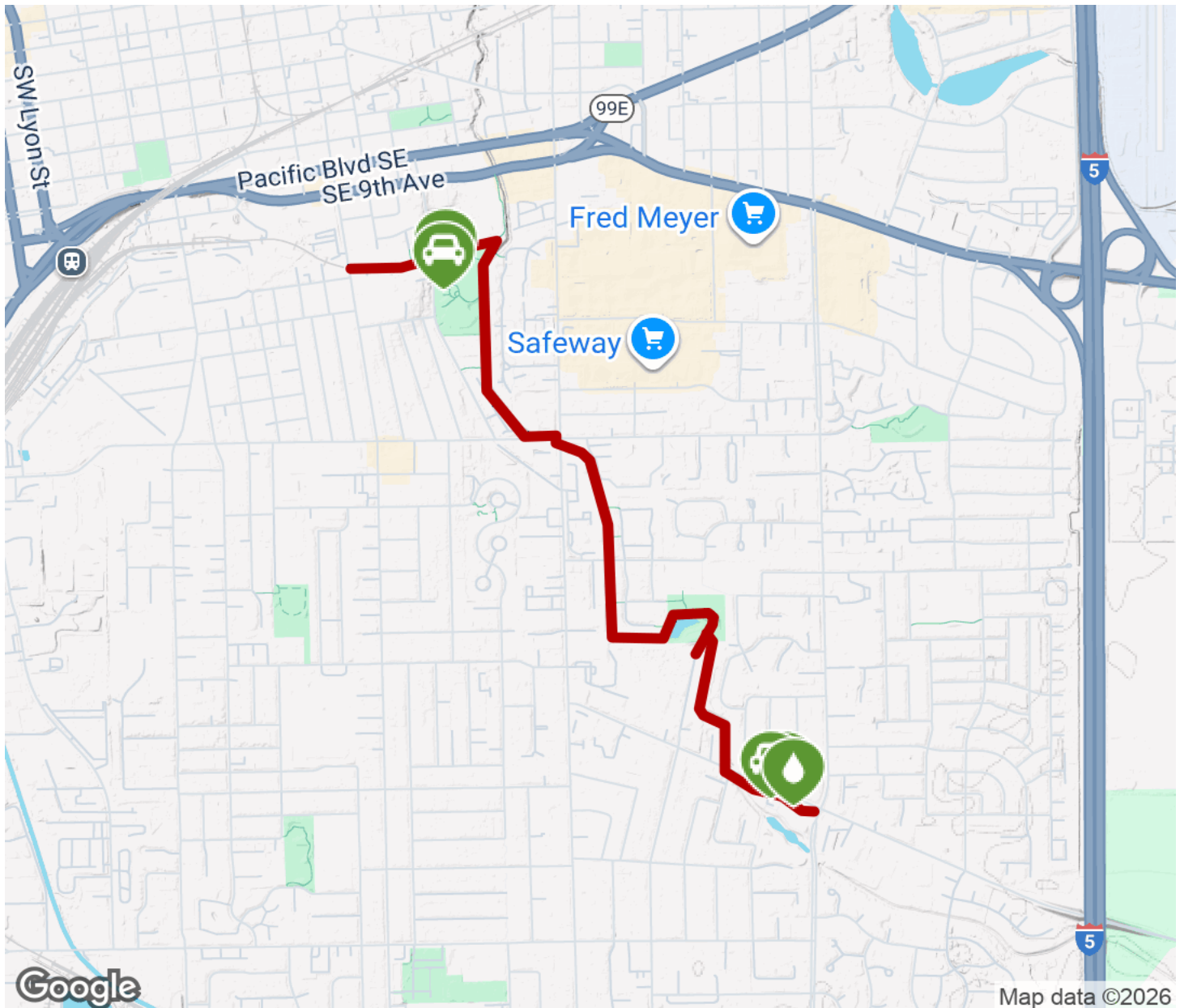
Parking & Trail Access
