The White River Greenway brings residents of Martinsville to the river, for rest, for relaxation and for education. The asphalt trail begins at Old Town Waverly Park, and follows the river's course southwest for 2 miles, through charming woods. In Autumn, the vegetation is bathed in Fall colors; in the Spring, migratory birds descend on the river. There are picnic tables at clearings beside the river, where visitors can share a meal or simply enjoy the view. The trail is also popular as a way to access the river for fishing.

Morgan County Parks manages the trail.


