You can approach the trail by bike or on foot, or park at the Santa Fe Village Park at Bogart Street and Bangor Avenue.



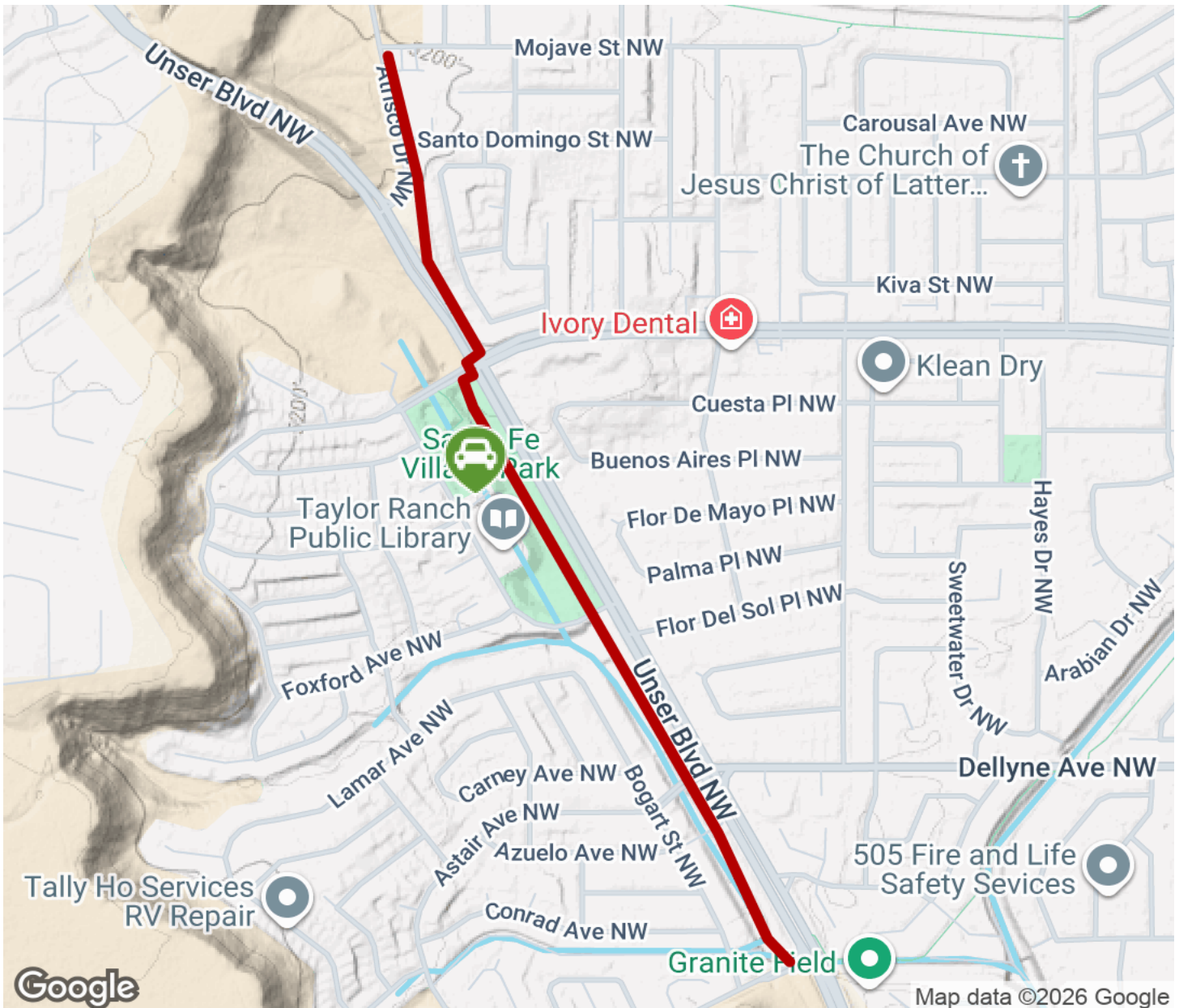
