The Southern Railroad trail occupies part of the former bed of the Harrisville Southern Railroad. The short line railroad was built to



The Southern Railroad trail occupies part of the former bed of the Harrisville Southern Railroad. The short line railroad was built to link Harrisville to the B&O line at Cornwallis, a total distance of 6 miles. The line operated between 1915 and 1929 but folded due to competition from road transport. Today, 0.8 miles of that is a hiking trail within the North Bend State Park, running between the River Run Campground and Jughandle Day Use Area.


