Ackelson Trail](#) at Easter Lake Park, the Easter Lake Spine Trail is a useful asset to the community and forms a key link in the evolving trail network in the city of Des Moines. Running between the backyards of the adjacent subdivision and a series of stormwater retention reservoirs, the trail provides a nice little path for outdoor recreation and exercise.

Plans are in the works to connect the trail with the [Carlisle Nature Trail](#) and the [Summerset Trail](#) outside Des Moines, which would form an unbroken chain of trails all the way from Indianola to southeastern Des Moines.



Parking & Trail Access
