The North Fork Trail begins beside US-12, intersecting with Middleton's other multiuse trails: specifically the US Highway 12



The North Fork Trail begins beside US-12, intersecting with Middleton's other multiuse trails: specifically the [US Highway 12 Path](#), [Pheasant Branch Creek Corridor Trail](#), and the [Deming Way Trail](#). The trail heads west, skirting the confluence pond on Pheasant Branch. It is sandwiched between the Middletown Corporate Center on one side and wetlands, then heads north into the Middleton Firefighters Memorial Park, a 24-acre park hosting 4 baseball diamonds. The trail then ducks below Airport Road. It traces the edge of the baseball and soccer fields and comes out into a parking lot at the Ed Tallard Park. There are additional unpaved trails weaving between the evergreens in the park.

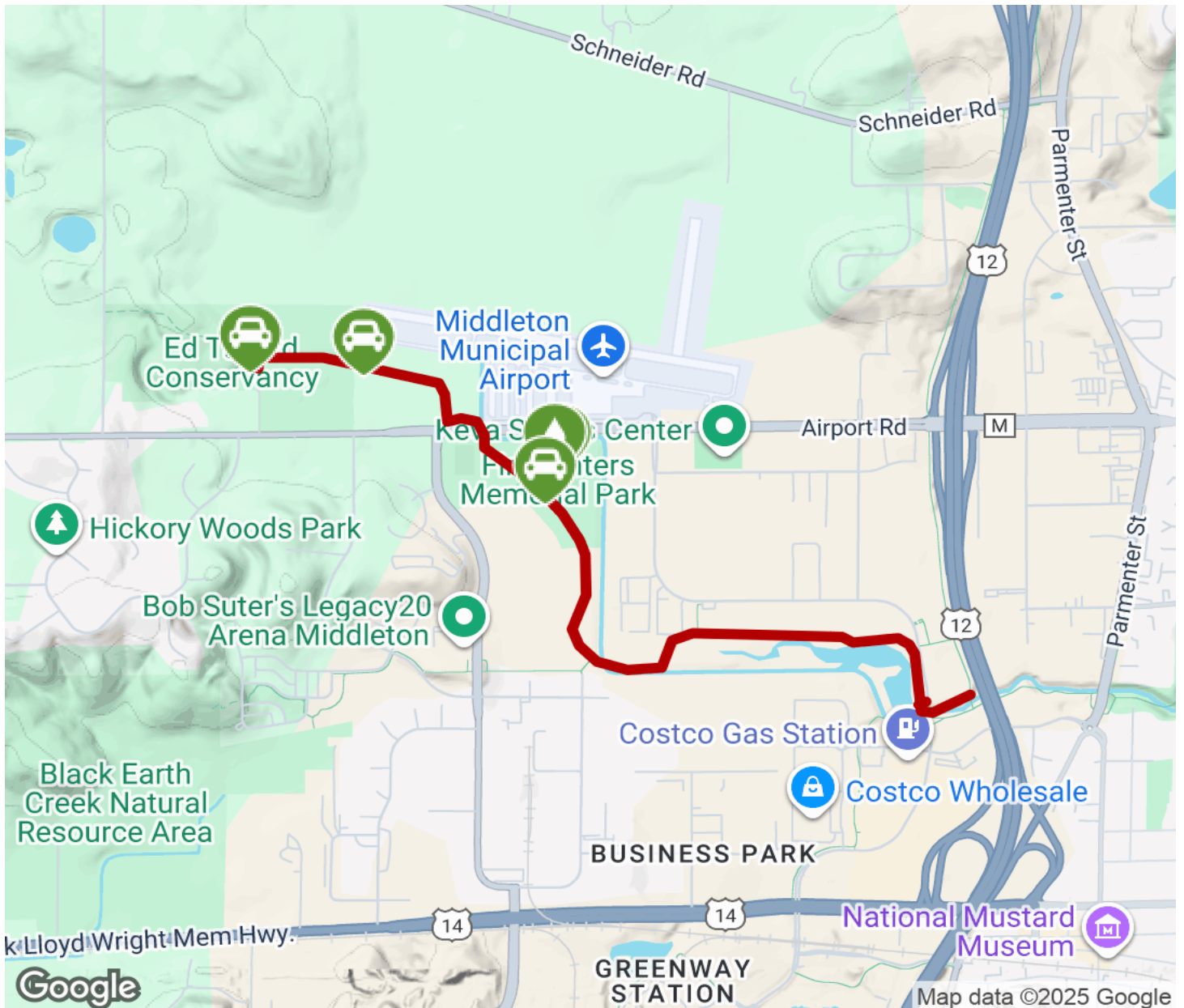
Parking & Trail Access
