Parking for the trail is available at the north end of the trail on Campus Drive, across from the baseball diamond. A smaller parking area is available on Dorothy Lane.



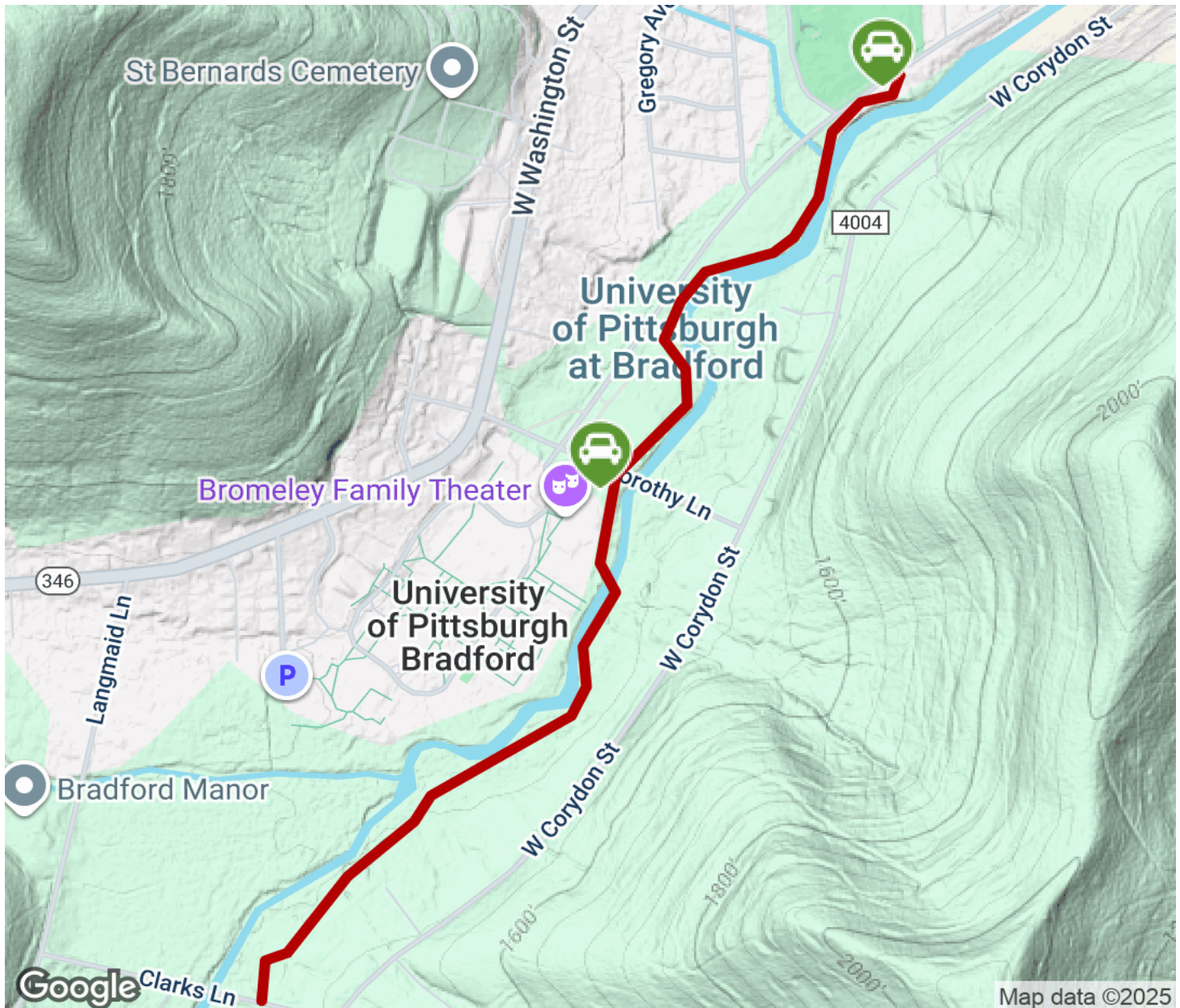
