The Downtown Greenway is a paved multiuse trails winding through Greensboro, North Carolina. The trail is close to 1.5 miles



The Downtown Greenway is a paved multiuse trails winding through Greensboro, North Carolina. The trail is close to 1.5 miles long, beginning on Spring Garden Street, with a landscaped buffer between the trail and Freeman Street. The trail starts heading south, passing under railroad tracks, before turning east to Martin Luther King Drive. The trail is suitable for walking, biking, jogging, dog-walking and rollerblading and connects residential and commercial areas.
