Heading south and east from the Mariposa Community Center, the trail has plenty of separation from the road, occupying a corridor lined with native shrubs and stubby trees as it descends along the edges of the area filled by suburban-style homes. The trail quickly reaches the limits of the subdivision, where the Mariposa Recreational Trail connects in from the southwest, and continues to weave along the side of the road all the way

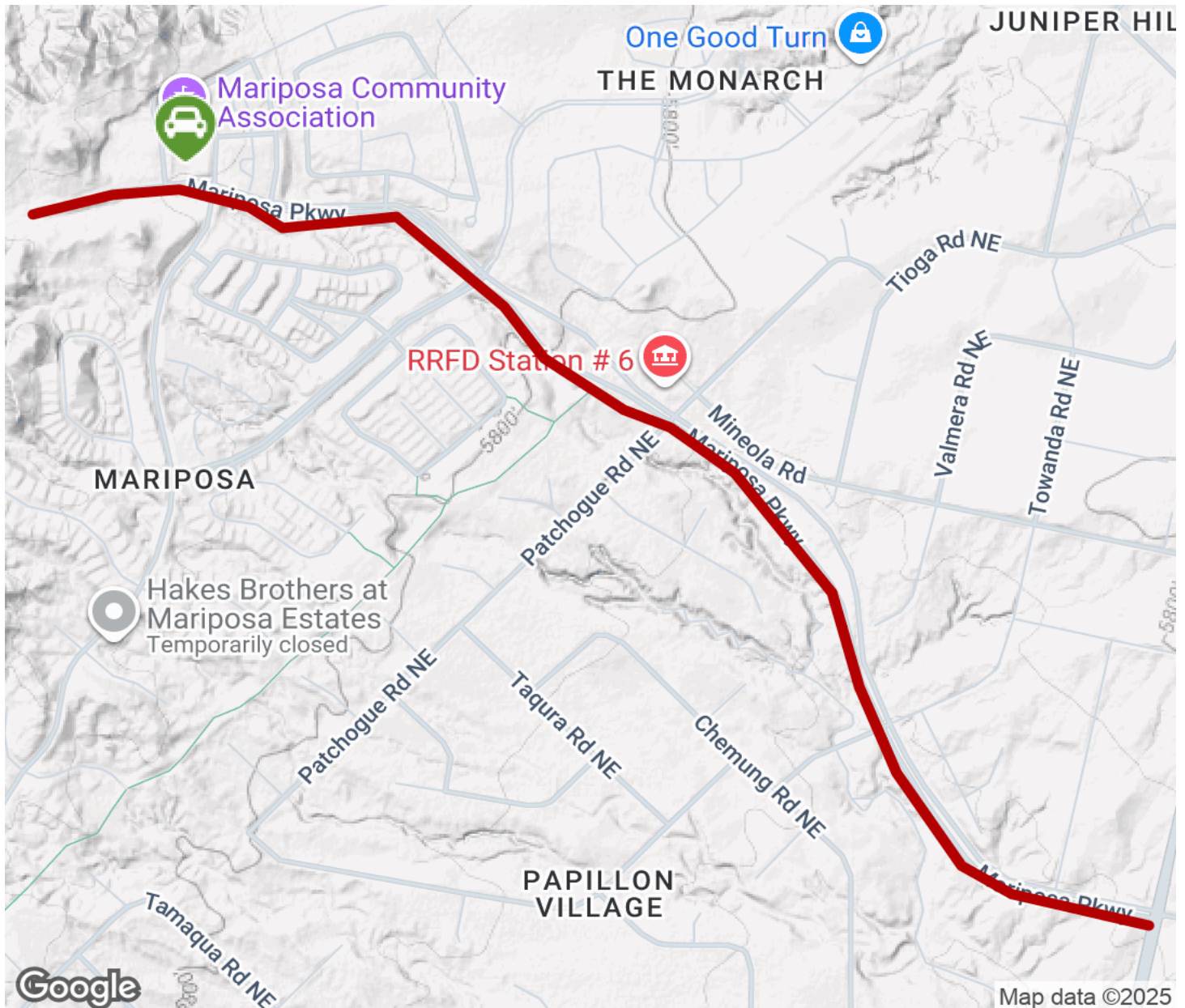
