A wide asphalt sidepath that runs the length of King Boulevard from Wilpert Road in the east to King Meadows Park in the west,



A wide asphalt sidepath that runs the length of King Boulevard from Wilpert Road in the east to King Meadows Park in the west, the King Boulevard Trail forms a solid connective backbone for the trail network that runs through the clustered subdivisions in this isolated section of western Rio Rancho. The trail connects with the beginnings of the [Arroyo Ponce de Leon Trail](#) and the [Arroyo de las Montoyas Trail](#), and gives residents an easy and convenient means of accessing several neighborhood parks and recreation sites.

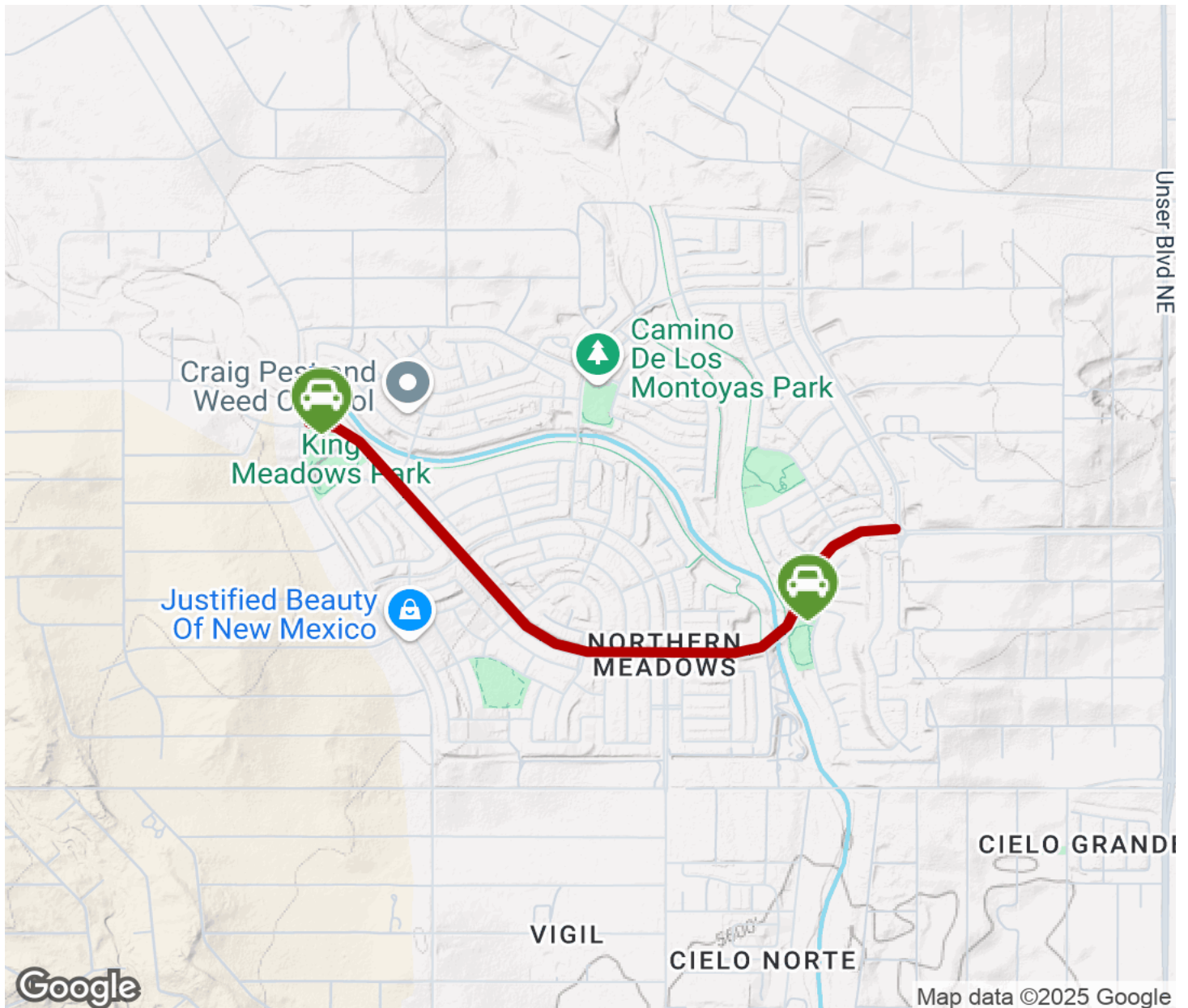
