The Sara Road Trail follows a suburban, residential street just off one of Rio Rancho's main drags, providing a shortcut between other sidepath trails in the community's extensive trail network. With a wide asphalt path running parallel to the sidewalk, the trail helps accommodate cyclists and quicker-moving off-road traffic as it runs from the <u>New Mexico 528 Rec Path</u> along the highway in the southeast to the <u>Southern Boulevard Trail</u> in the north. While the trail doesn't offer anything worth going out of your way for, it provides a useful community connection, making another mile of multi-use trail available for transportation and recreation.


Parking & Trail Access
