The multi-use pathway runs parallel to Bull Creek and links Harl-Holt Park to Washington Elementary, Schuler Elementary and Atlantic Middle Schools, as well as the YMCA. Students can take the path to and from school and after-school activities. Residents can use it to get their steps in or walk their dogs. There are trailside benches as well as play equipment on the Harl-Holt Park end.


Parking & Trail Access
