A short community sidepath trail that runs along its namesake boulevard in southeastern Albuquerque, the Juan Tabo Trail provides a stretch of wide, paved asphalt that forms a part of the off-road transportation network in this suburban enclave.

Connecting in the north to the <u>Sandia Science and</u> <u>Technology Trail</u>, the two trails together enable you to walk or bike on a paved multi-use trail around the entirety of the residential and industrial park communities that make up this section of development south of Southern Boulevard.
