

Wingfield Springs Trail Nevada



A short community pathway that follows the outskirts of a suburban development in northern Sparks, the Wingfield Springs Trail



A short community pathway that follows the outskirts of a suburban development in northern Sparks, the Wingfield Springs Trail provides a path for recreation and exercise that leads from Wingfield Springs Road west and north to La Posada Drive.

The trail follows a shrub-lined corridor away from the suburban grid of roads, reaching part of the Orr Ditch, a lengthy irrigation ditch that forms a green corridor through the dry surroundings. At the ditch, the trail turns from asphalt to concrete and from west to north, continuing along a corridor on the eastern edge of a newly-developing subdivision. Reaching La Posada Drive, a wide sidepath along the roadway helps trail users connect between this trail and the Wingfield Utility Corridor Trail further to the east.
