While Ridgeland is known for the <u>Chisha Foka Multi-Use Trail</u>, the city has shared use paths scattered across the city. One strategy has been to have multi-use paths along roadways, as is the case along the Colony Park Boulevard. The Colony Park Blvd Multi-Use Trail travels for nearly 2 miles along the south side of the road, connecting to Ridgeland High School as well as Ridgeland Tennis Center and Wolcott Park on the east side, across from US 51.
