Great Divide Bike Trail

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The Great Divide Trail sits is a one mile non-motorized trail through a neighborhood at the northern tip of Joliet, Illinois. The paved trail, which sits in the shadow of electric transmission lines, starts on Old Renwick Road, and heads southwest, through Old Renwick Park, before concluding at Indian Head Lane. The pathway is suitable for uses including walking, jogging, biking and rollerblading.

There is no dedicated parking for this trail but residents can access the trail on foot or by bike.



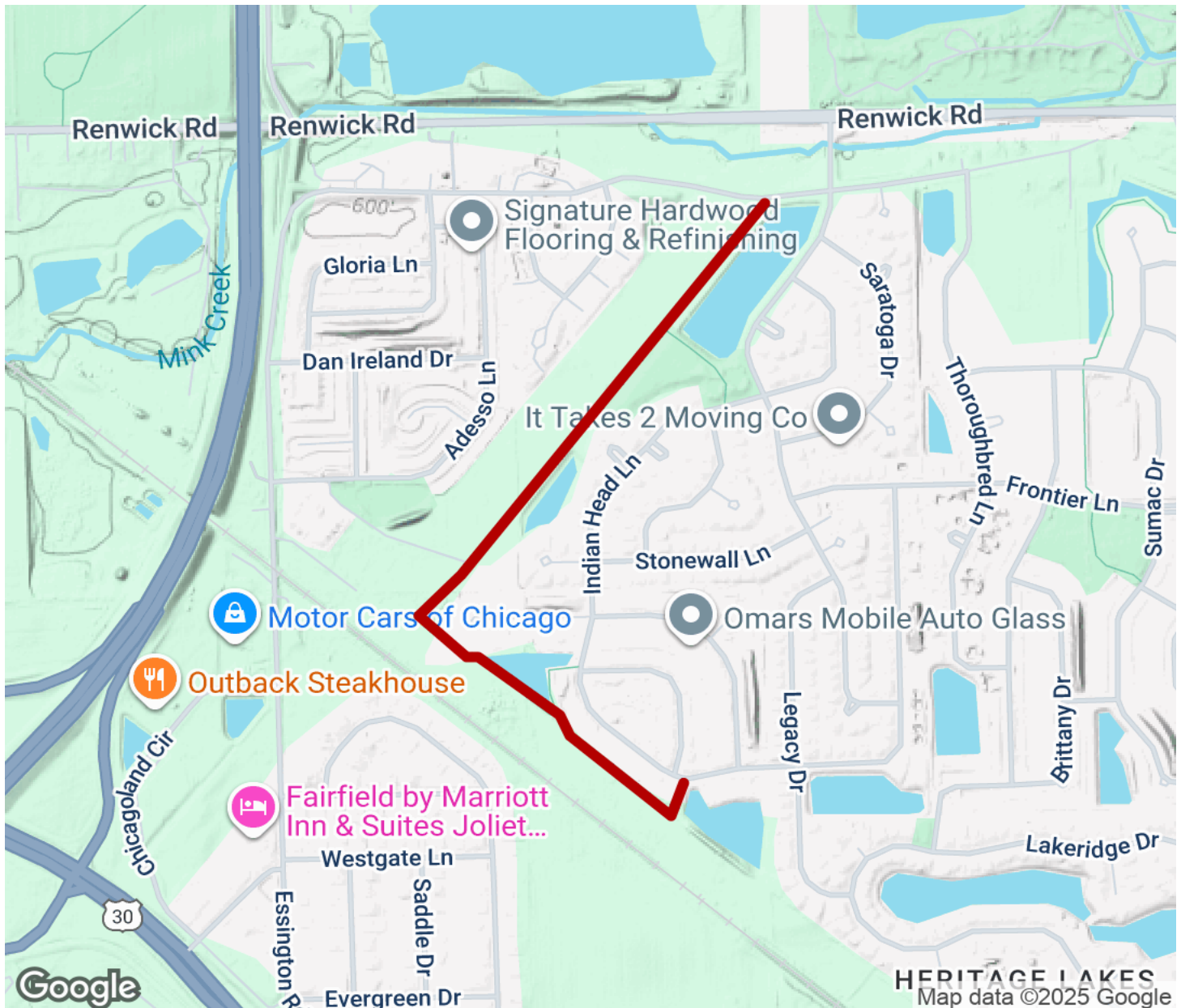
