Lester Matzen Bike Path

Iowa



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The Lester Matzen Bike Path is named in memory of an Eldridge man who is fondly remembered for collecting and restoring bicycles. The trail stretches along Le Claire Road between 1st Street and 18th Avenue and is perpendicular to the [Eldridge/ Long Grove Trail](#), which connects to the neighboring city of Long Grove. The trail also provides access to the North Scott Senior High School on its west end, making it a safe way to commute to school for the town's youth.

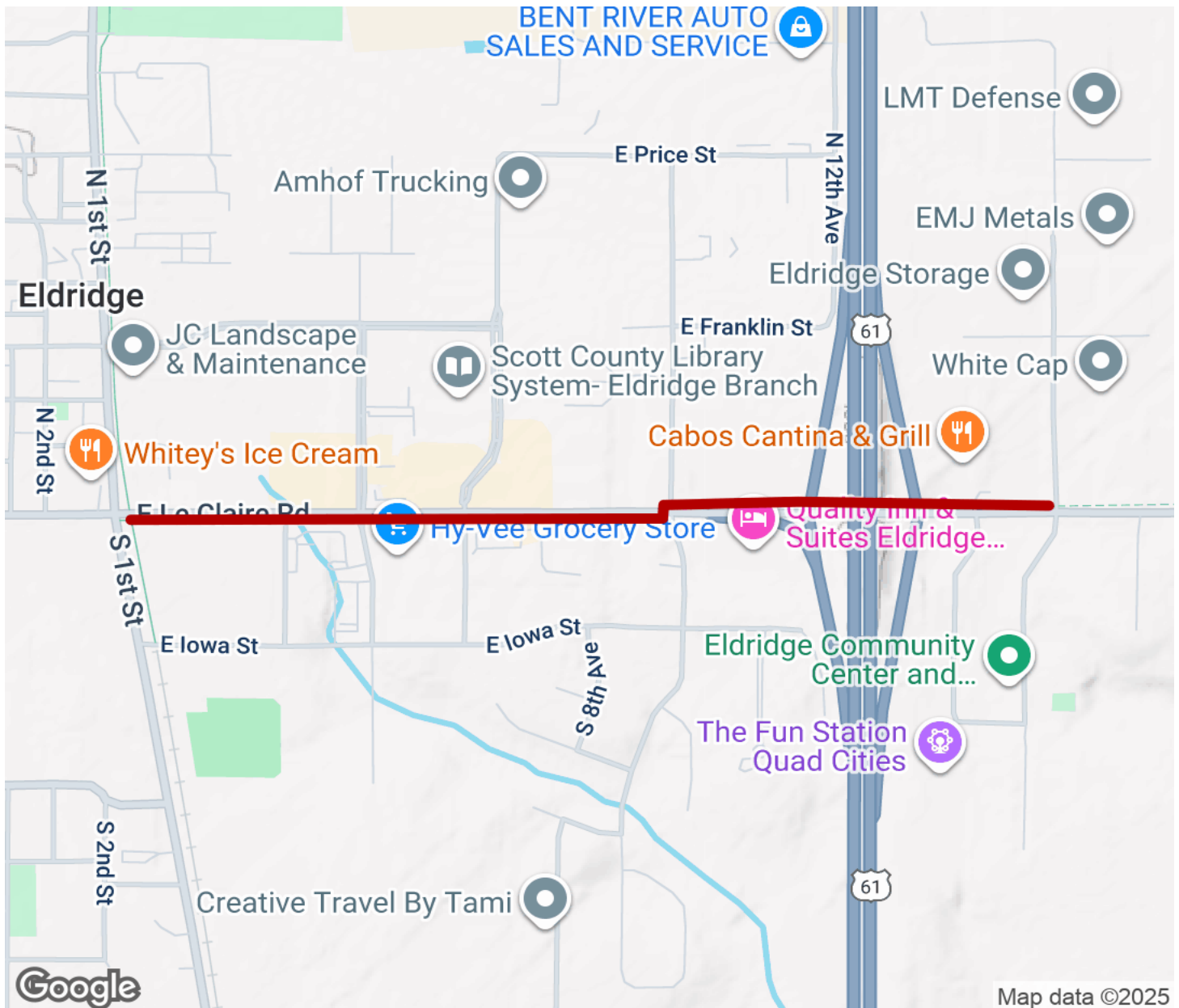
