Located in Grove City, a suburb of Columbus, this shared use path follows along Buckeye Parkway in Grove City for approximately four miles. On the east end, the park passes by two large shopping centers, with a variety of shopping, retail and entertainment options. A little further down, users can access the Pinnacle Community Center. As it continues southwest, the setting becomes decidedly more residential. The endpoint of the trail is at the intersection of Buckeye Parkway and London-Groveport Road. The trail is paved and suitable for walking, biking and other non-motorized uses.

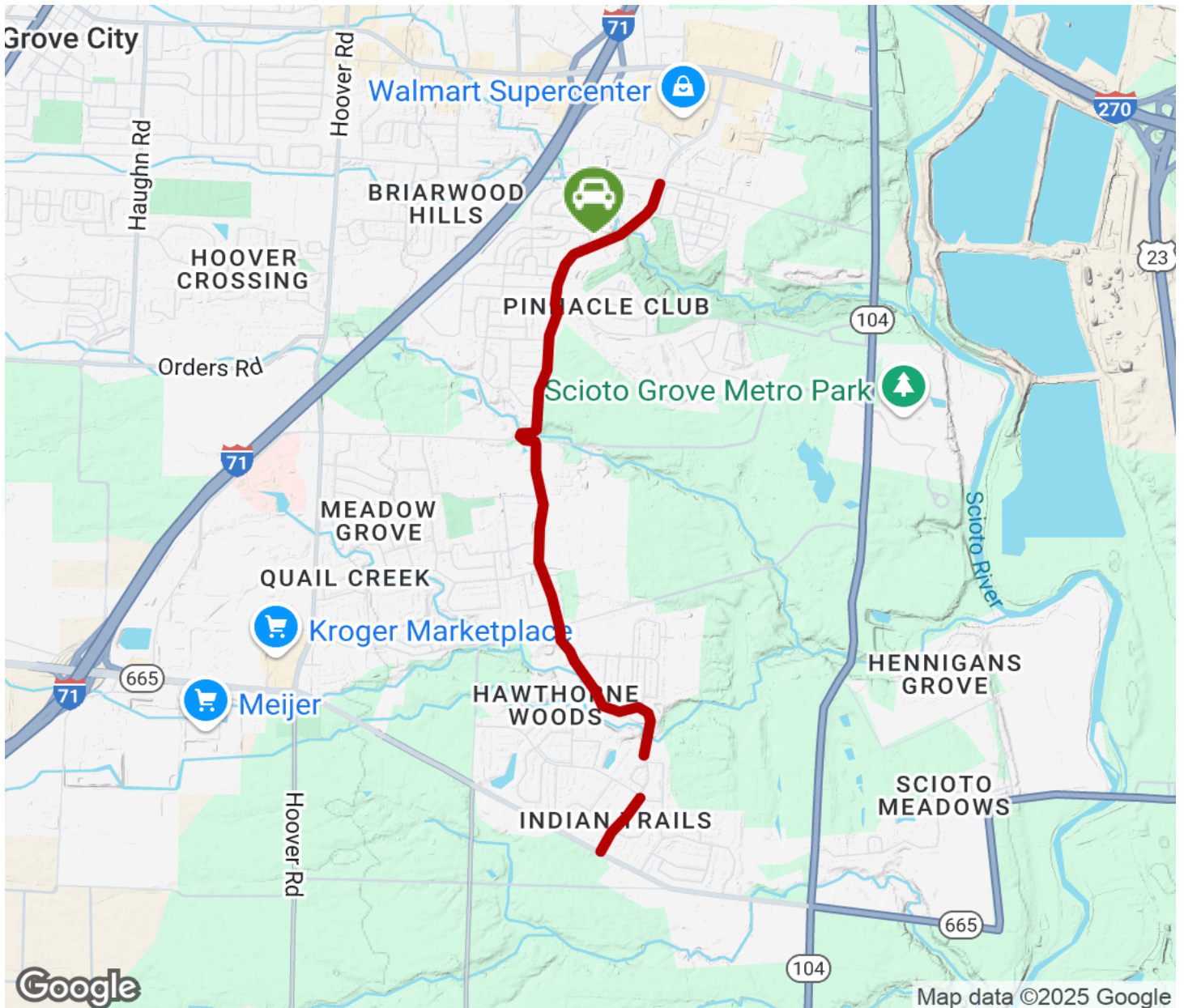
