Squires Road Trail is a 1.3 mile multiuse trail on the southeast edge of Lexington, KY. The trail begins on Squires Road and threads through neighborhoods until its terminus at Summerhill Road. Residents make use the trail to get some exercise, walk dogs or socialize. The trail is wide asphalt with bollards at the access points to prevent motor vehicles from using it. Use it to get to Berry Hill Park at around the midway point, a shopping center right across from the park, and Squires Elementary School close to the Summerhill Road end.
