The Pflugerville Parkway Trail allows to cross from the east side of the Austin suburb, to the west without the use of a car. Single-family homes in fast-growing subdivisions dominate the scenery along the concrete pathway, interspersed with fields and pastures. The trail is best for those looking for a safe space to exercise close to home. While there is greenery around, there are no trees so keep that in mind if going out on a hot day. There's not much signage to be seen, but fortunately, the route is very straightforward - just stay on the north side of the parkway between Greenlawn Boulevard and Colorado Sand Drive.

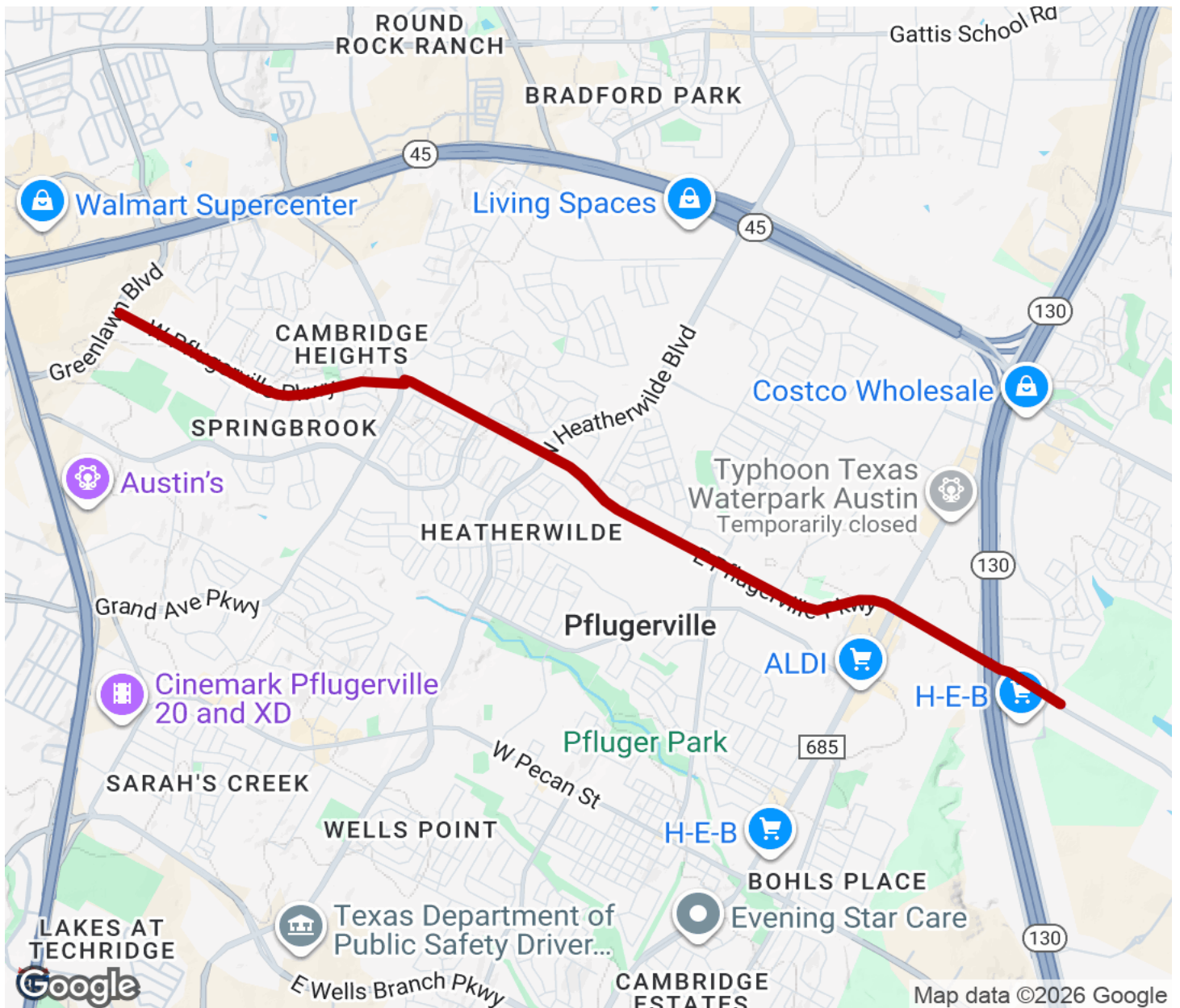
