The Edwards Mill Connector in West Raleigh is an offshoot of the Reedy Creek Trail. The shared use is adjacent to Edwards Mill Road, and stretches down to Chapel Hill Road. On the way, the trail passes near the North Carolina State sports complex, which includes the PNC Arena and the Carter-Finley Stadium. There are several multi-lane crossings, including one under Wade Avenue.
