The trail, as its name suggests, links the North Carolina State University's Centennial campus to [Walnut Creek Trail](#). At 19 miles Walnut Creek is one of the most popular pathways in Raleigh's trail complex, and itself intersects with other area trails including [Rocky Branch](#), [Little Rock](#), and the [Neuse River Trail](#). The North Carolina State Farmer's Market, just off Centennial Parkway, can also be accessed via the Bikeway Connector.


