Latham Park Greenway

North Carolina

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Latham Park Greenway sits nestled among the neighborhoods of Latham Park, Iriving Park and Fisher Park in Greensboro. A concrete trail runs the length of Latham Park, from North Elm Street south to Hill Street. The trail parallels the winding North Buffalo Creek. Fitness stations dot the trailside for those interested in a more varied workout than a bike ride or run. Latham Park is also home to other sports facilities including baseball diamonds, tennis courts and a skate park.

Users can connect to the Lake Daniel Greenway via the Hill Street Connector Trail.

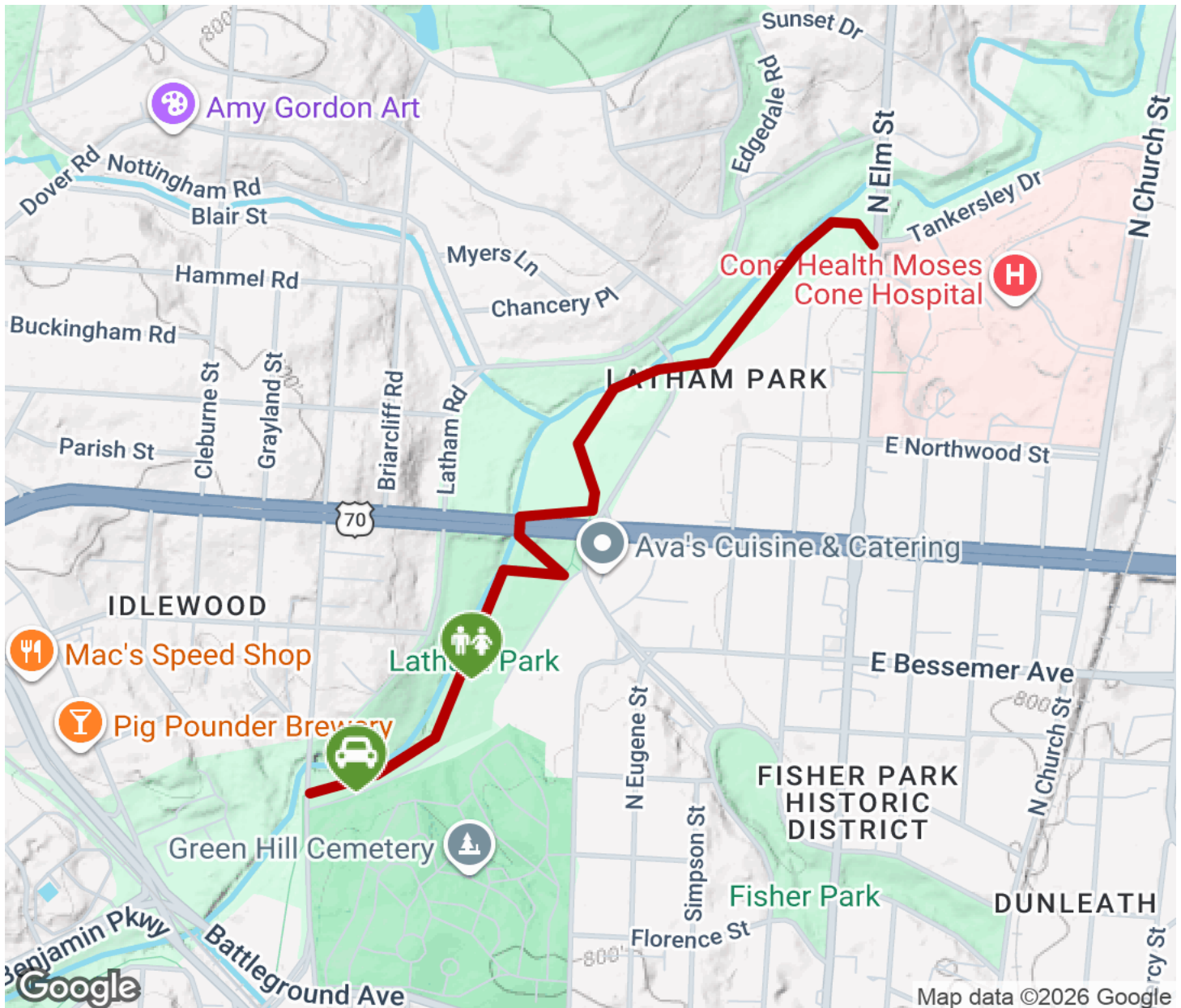
