The trail starts downtown on East 4th Street, crosses the Etowah River, and ends on 12th Street just across from the Floyd County Health Department. 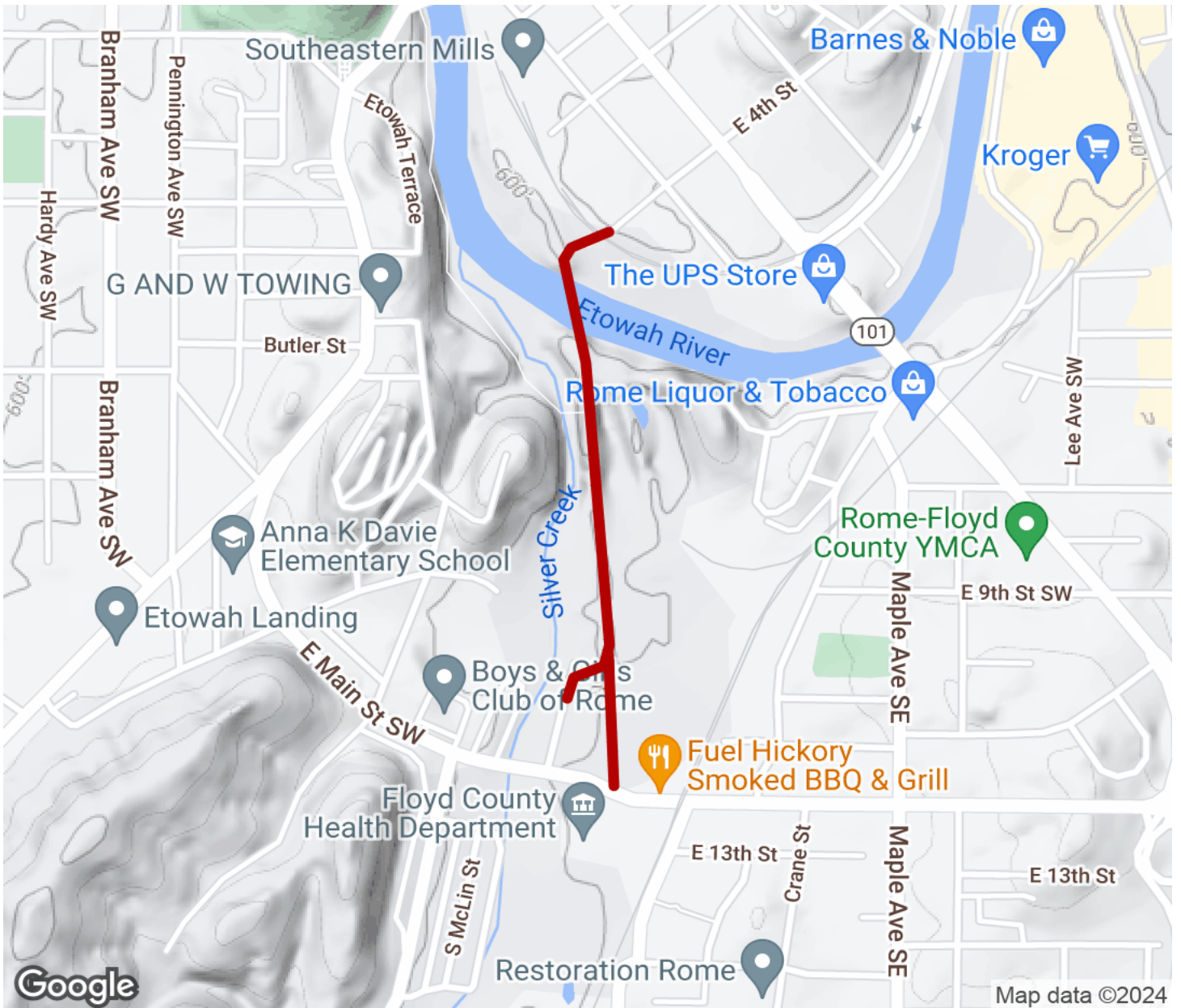
