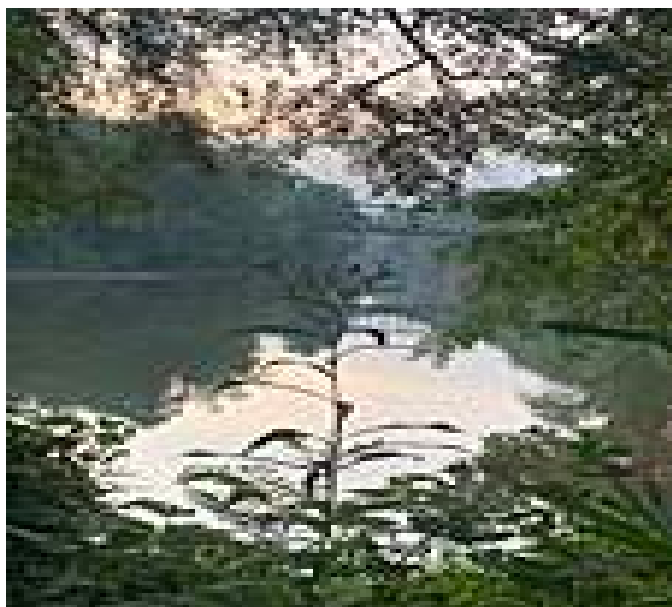

A small parking lot is located at the northern end of the trail, on Branham Avenue just north of the Broad Street bridge.



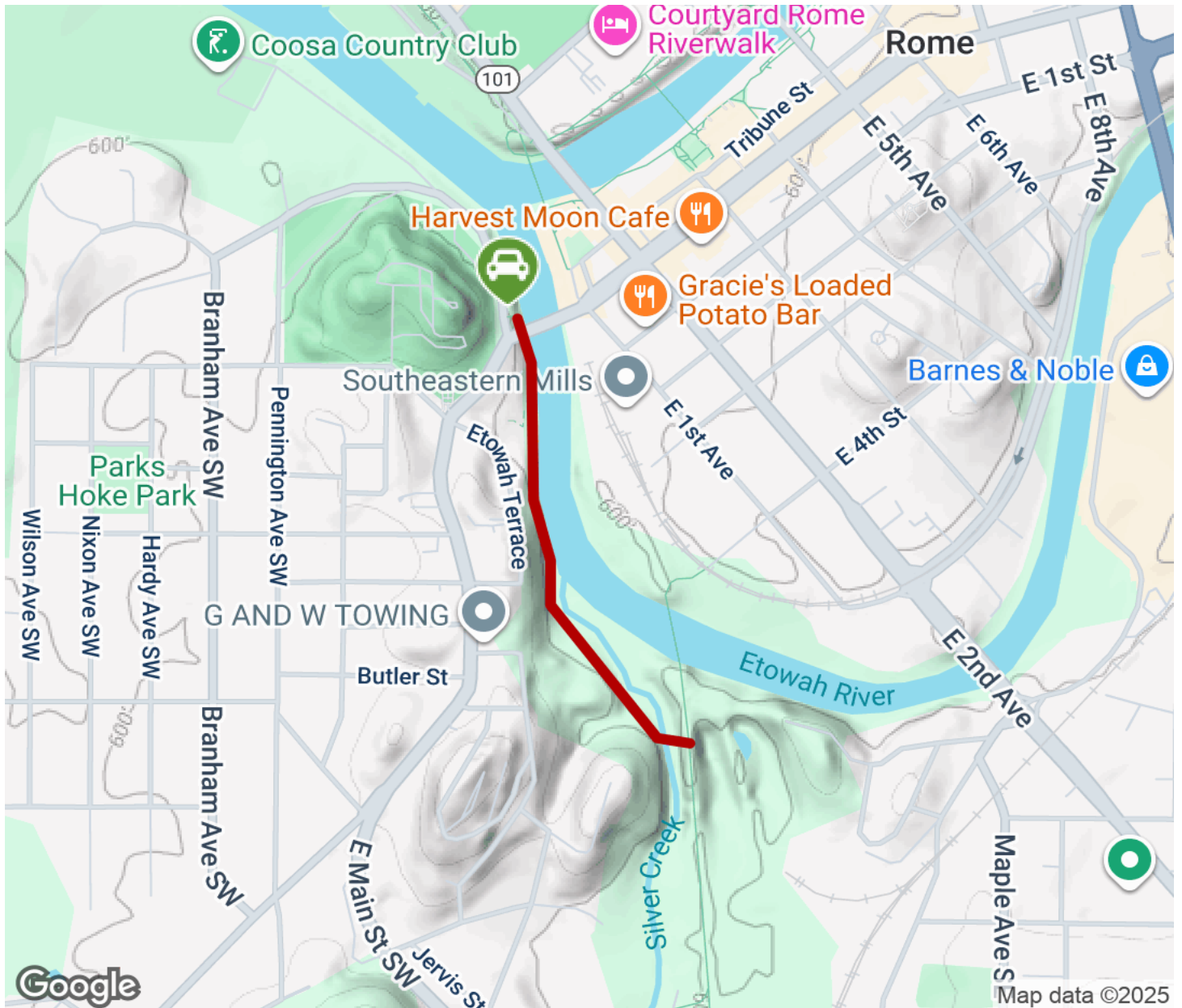
