In San Benito, an asphalt trail sits on both sides of the landscaped green verge of a section of the Resaca de los Fresnos. The park space is populated with amenities including fitness stations, picnic tables and shelters, swing sets, outdoor grills, basketball courts and more. It serves as the site of many local events from races to music festivals.

The Heavin Resaca Trail is also part of the <u>Caracara Trails</u> network in Lower Rio Grande Valley.
