Peace Portal Community Trail

Washington



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Jogging, rollerblading, walking dogs, pushing strollers and riding bikes are some of the ways that residents of Blaine take advantage of the Peace Portal Community Trail. At 10-feet wide, the trail comfortably accommodates multiple uses. The trail takes you past pastel-colored waterfront homes while providing views of Drayton Harbor, although vegetation and a railroad embankment end up obscuring the water for part of the way.

At present, the trail parallels Peace Portal Drive between Cherry Street and Hughes Drive, but a third phase will see it continue south to Bell Road. The trail also serves as a taste of what's to come with the Coast Millenium Trail, a planned trail spanning the Whatcom County coastline.

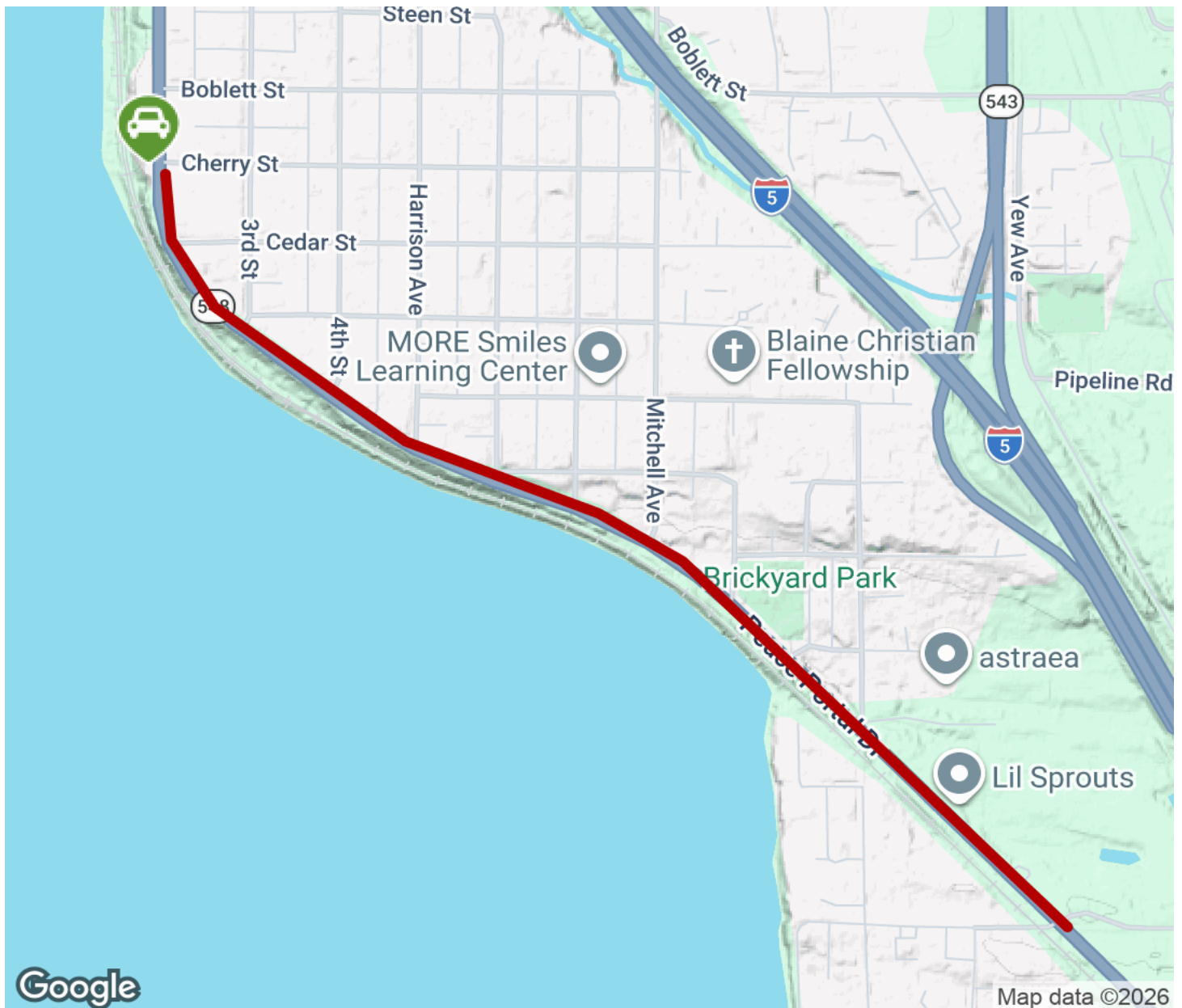
Parking & Trail Access
