Emanuel Cleaver II Boulevard South Trail

This is a shared use path adjacent to one of Kansas City's major east-west conduits. The concrete path sits on the wide grassy verge



This is a shared use path adjacent to one of Kansas City's major east-west conduits. The concrete path sits on the wide grassy verge of the boulevard, which is named for a former mayor.

On the other side of the roadway lies Brushy Creek, which has its own <u>multiuse path</u> winding through it. Cross Cleaver II Boulevard at Elmwood Avenue to access the Brush Creek, its greenway park and trail.
