Parking is available near the start of the trail at Legion Park, next to the YMCA, at the intersection of North 1st Street and Cherry Street.



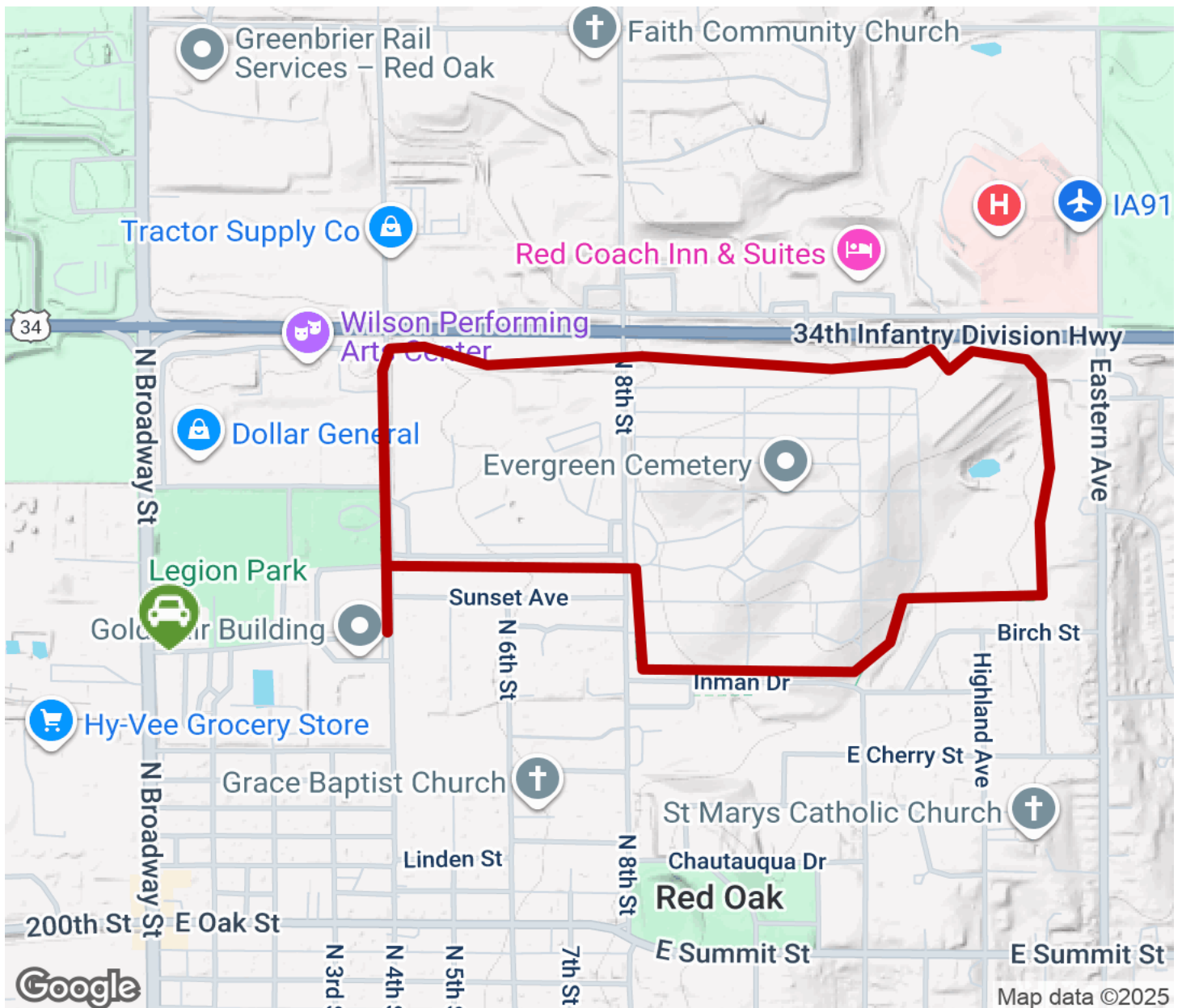
