The Jessen Path is a short, concrete trail for cyclists and pedestrians that runs along Jessen Drive in northwestern Eugene. The trail, constructed in 2018, gives nearby residents a nice, smooth pathway for exercise and recreation, and provides access to Golden Gardens Park and the small lake of the same name - keep your eye out for a variety of local wildlife near the lake, such as beavers and herons. On the trail's eastern end, you can connect with the [Randy Pape Beltline Path](#), which travels north and south along the roadway.

No dedicated trail parking is available; parking may be available on nearby streets, but be sure to follow any posted parking signs and regulations.



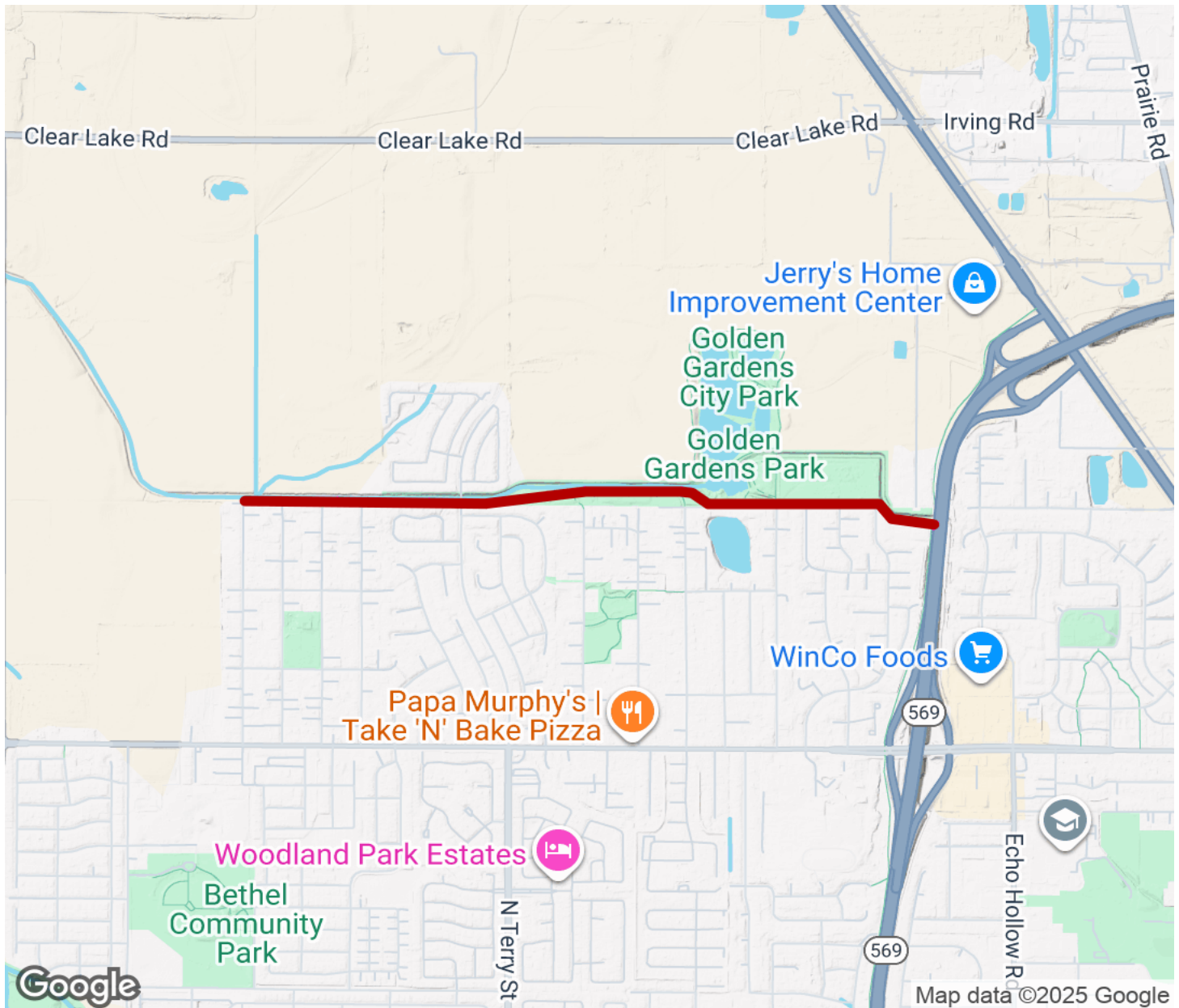
