The trails run the gamut from long regional trails to shorter, neighborhood pathways. The Yankee Doodle Trail is a local recreational path traveling east-west nestled in the greenbelt between homes. The trail connects to Stott Elementary as well as to Yankee Doodle Park, which features a playground, tennis courts and a pond with landscaped grassy banks.


