Named in the memory of Arianna Celeste Macnamara, a 7-year old girl who was tragically killed when she was struck by a car while crossing a nearby intersection, the Arianna Celeste Macnamara Memorial Bridge aims to help prevent similar tragedies by providing a safe, off-road connection for cyclists and pedestrians between the [Cascade Creek Trail](#) and the [Douglas-Cascade Trail](#) in Rochester. The bridge crosses over US Highway 14, a set of railroad tracks, and 7th Street NW, allowing trail users to easily bypass these barriers, helping to tie together Rochester's growing trail network.


Parking & Trail Access
