The Bear Creek Cutoff Trail serves as a short connector trail, allowing cyclists and pedestrians access to and from the southern end of the <u>Bear Creek Trail</u>. The asphalt pathway spans from 11th Avenue to Marion Road in southern Rochester, right at the confluence of Willow Creek and Bear Creek; while the trail does run alongside a suburban roadway, the scenery to the north and south is quite pleasant, filled with forests and wildlife thanks to the nearby creeks. Trail users can also connect to the <u>Marion Road Bike Path</u> on the eastern end of the cutoff trail, which provides a paved sidepath connection to adjacent neighborhoods, schools, and parks.


Parking & Trail Access
