Bear Creek Cutoff Trail

Minnesota



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The Bear Creek Cutoff Trail serves as a short connector trail, allowing cyclists and pedestrians access to and from the southern end of the [Bear Creek Trail](#). The asphalt pathway spans from 11th Avenue to Marion Road in southern Rochester, right at the confluence of Willow Creek and Bear Creek; while the trail does run alongside a suburban roadway, the scenery to the north and south is quite pleasant, filled with forests and wildlife thanks to the nearby creeks. Trail users can also connect to the [Marion Road Bike Path](#) on the eastern end of the cutoff trail, which provides a paved sidepath connection to adjacent neighborhoods, schools, and parks.

Parking is available at the start of the Bear Creek Trail in the Jean & Carl Frank Canine Park, located at 1839 Pinewood Road.



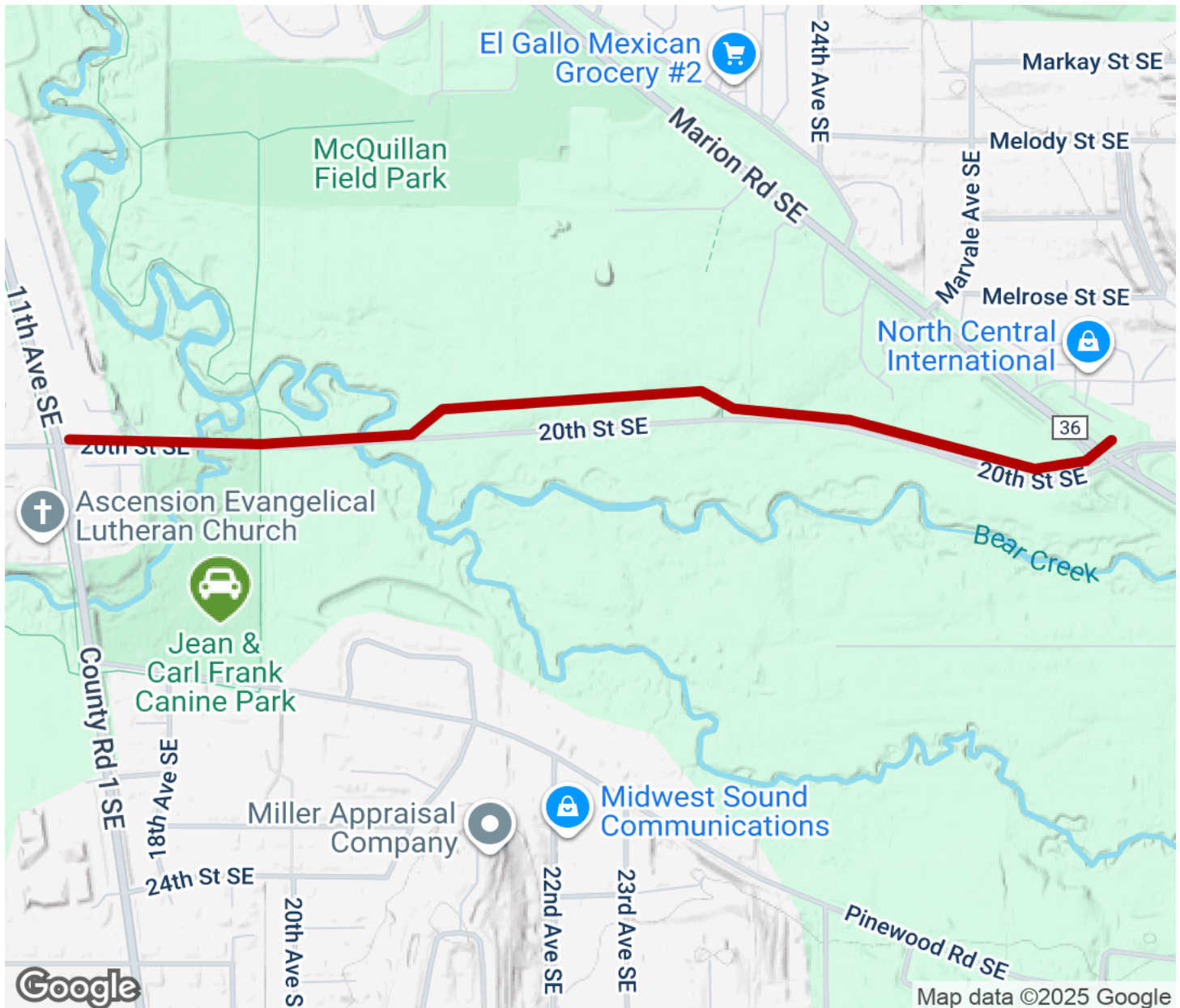
