The concrete pathway travels in the space between houses while providing connections to three local parks: Arvada Volunteer Firefighters Park, Rainbow Park 2 and Rainbow Park 3. 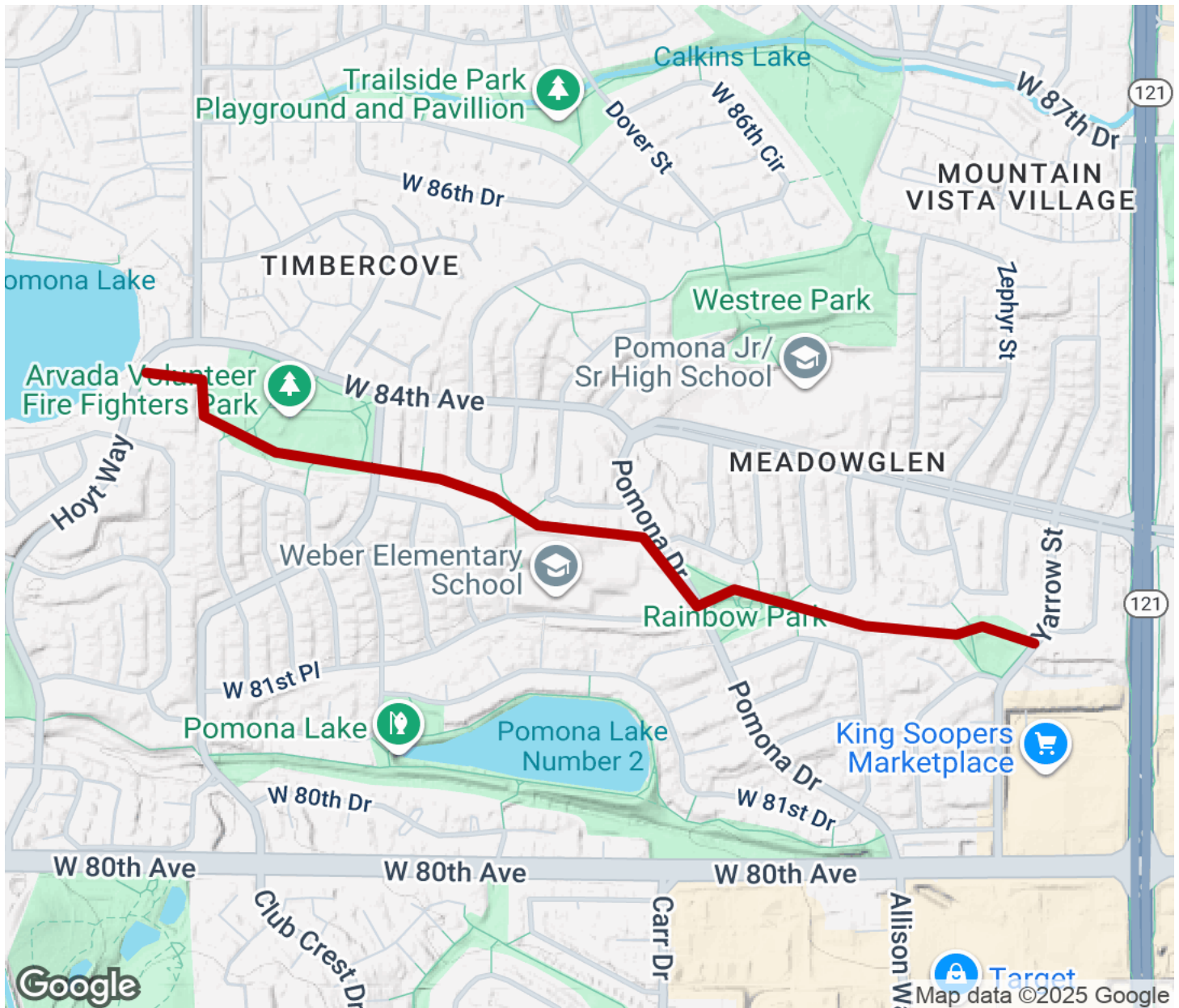
