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The Hardy Trail is a mile long walk or ride in the heart of Dade City. The trail sits on a converted railbed, and travels south from Church Avenue. Residents love using the trail to run or jog or walk their dogs. It is an easy walk - flat, paved and shaded and equipped with water fountains and dog waste bag dispensers. There are plans to extend the trail north from Church Avenue to Lock Street.

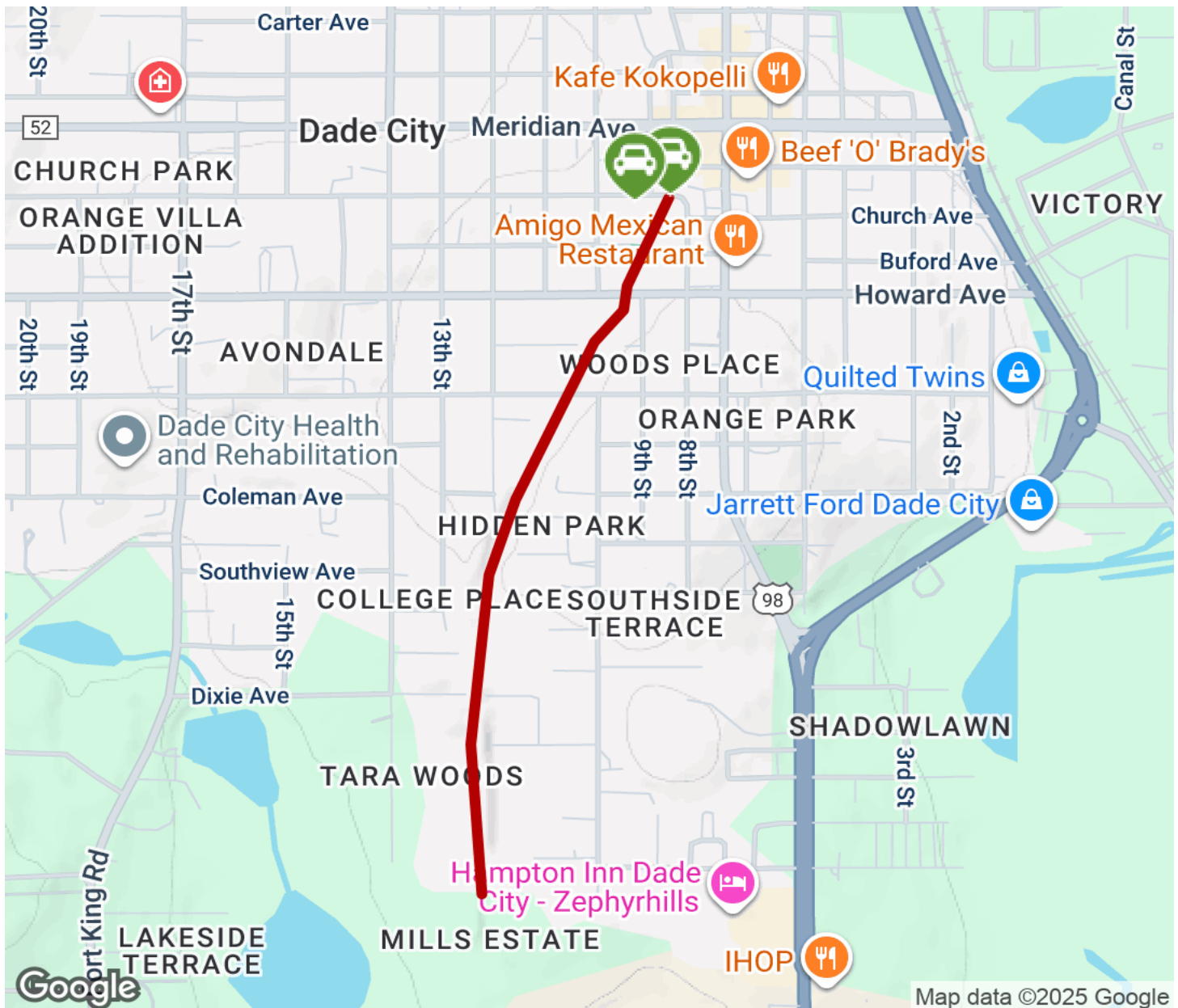
Parking & Trail Access
