Covering a residential section of northwestern Rochester, the West 55th Street Path helps connect neighborhood residents with the rest of Rochester's expansive trail network, including the lovely and popular [Douglas State Trail](#), which marks the eastern end of the path. This asphalt sidepath offers little more than a smooth, straight roadside route for walking dogs or jogging, but those looking for longer or more scenic routes will be well-served by the trails it connects to.

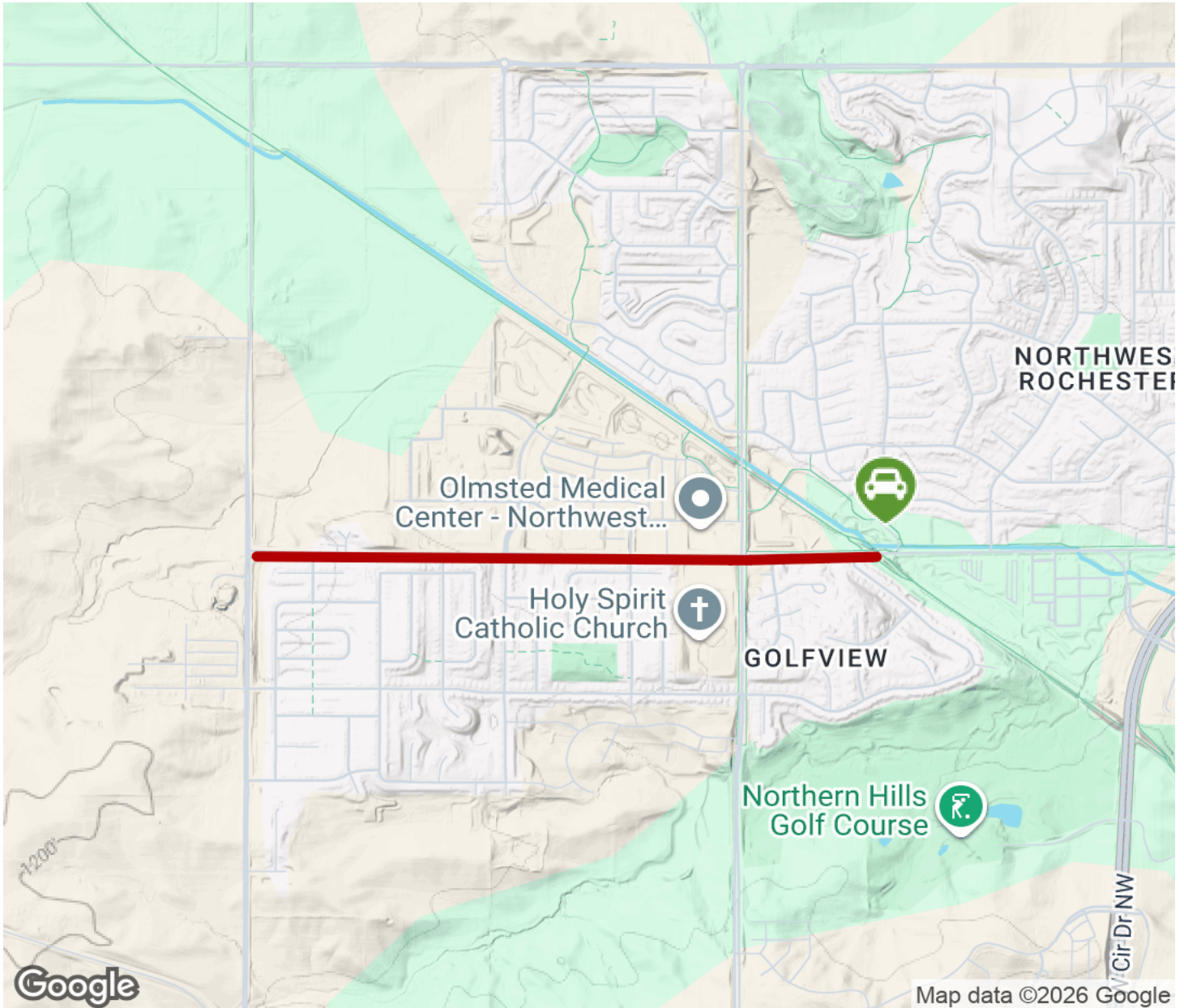
Parking & Trail Access
