The East 55th Street Path is an asphalt sidepath that runs along the side of 55th Street through a suburban stretch of northern



The East 55th Street Path is an asphalt sidepath that runs along the side of 55th Street through a suburban stretch of northern Rochester, providing a key connection in the area's bike and pedestrian trail network. The trail picks up where the [Zumbro North Trail](#) ends near Essex Park, and heads west to join up with a series of additional paths, which trail users can utilize to reach the popular [Douglas State Trail](#). Due to its roadside nature, the trail requires a number of road crossings, so be sure to exercise caution and obey traffic signals.

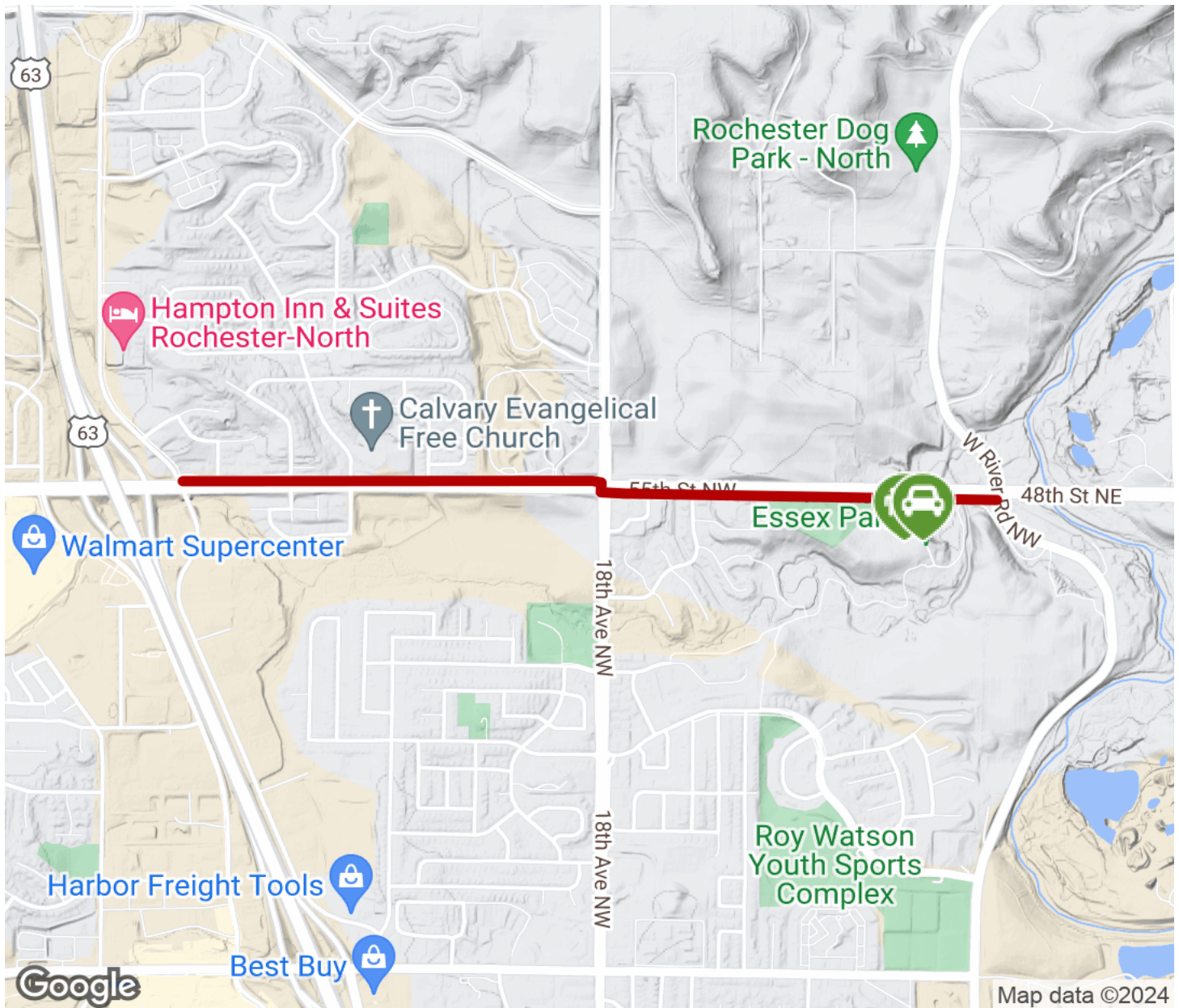
Parking & Trail Access
